Marks will be assigned roughly according to the following criteria:

- 4 is reserved for truly excellent work (e.g., a presentation that highlights unusual creativity or originality would rate a 4 on the third criterion)
- 3 indicates satisfactory performance in a category (e.g., presenters that communicate well and clearly with their audience might rate a 3 on the second criterion)
- 2 indicates some problems in a category (e.g., an otherwise solid presentation that must be cut off because of the time limit might receive a 2 for organization)
- 1 indicates an issue that seriously detracted from a presentation's overall quality (e.g., a presentation that doesn't touch on goals might rate a 1 on the first criterion)
- 0 is reserved for presentations that completely fail in a category (e.g., a presentation that provides no explicit indication at all of challenge or problem faced and how solution was developed to address the problem might rate a 0 on the fifth criterion)
