Notice to Exhibitors

Exhibitors, through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC rules and regulations including, but not limited to, the following:

- This event will be held in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Agility Association of Canada (AAC). The obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the AAC Official Rules and Regulations and shall conform to AAC specifications
- All breeds and mixed breeds eighteen months of age and older (no exceptions) are eligible to compete. Blind, lame, or aggressive dogs are ineligible as are bitches in season, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance (judge's discretion).
- All dogs must have an AAC Registration Number before their entries will be accepted in an AAC sanctioned trial. The registration form is available at www.aac.ca,
- Dogs with numbers pending will not be eligible to compete.
- No toys, food, or other training devices shall be allowed in the ring.
- All dogs must be **under control** (ie. penned, crated, or leashed) when not in the ring. Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may be asked by the Trial Committee to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds for entries if the dog or handler is *dismissed* from the competition for any reason.
- Electronic timing will be used at the trial.

ENTRIES

- The Canine Agility Association of Nova Scotia (CAANS) reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Anyone not in good standing with AAC / CAANS will not be allowed to enter the trial.
- Cheques or money orders can be made payable to CAANS and dated no later than the closing date. Entries must be "received by" the closing date. <u>WE NO LONGER ACCEPT CASH!</u>
- Refunds will not be given for cancellations after the closing date except for bitches in season or injury to a dog (veterinarian certificate required), or handler, which physically prevents them from competing. Refunds requested for any other reason will be handled on a case by case basis and will be at the discretion of the CAANS Trial Committee.
- By AAC rules, entries are not valid until payment of entry fees has been received or confirmed.
- Regionals: the regional qualifier for Nationals is open to Regular, Specials, and Veterans dogs. No Q's are available for Regionals. This event is open to all dogs registered with the AAC and over the age of 18 months. All dogs must enter and run 2 Standards, 2 Jumpers, and 2 Gamblers courses.
- You are not required to enter Regionals to enter the Steeplechase and Master Standard and Master Jumper courses.
- The 2 Steeplechase events held this weekend do not count towards the Steeplechase competition being held during our REGULAR trials.

AAC CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Masters: Open to dogs that have earned an AADC title.

Regular: Dogs will jump standard heights and course times as set by AAC rules.

Specials: Open to all dogs. Course times and jump heights will be as per AAC rules

Veterans: For dogs 7 years of age or older in the case of dogs who have been competing in Regular classes; for dogs 5 years of age or older who have been competing in the Specials division for a minimum of one year. Once a dog has entered an official trial in the Veterans division, they may no longer compete in the Regular or Specials divisions. Course times and jump heights will be as per AAC rules.

JUNIOR HANDLERS

- Junior Handlers must have their own AAC Junior Handler ID.
- A handler entered in the junior class may not compete in regular classes (including games) at the same AAC trial.
- Entry Fee: \$10.00 per class
- It is the responsibility of the Junior Handler / Guardian to be aware of the AAC rules pertaining to the Junior Handler Program.

VOLUNTEERS

It is extremely difficult to find timers and scribes for the Regional Championships as these people cannot be competing. ACCOMMODATIONS

There are several hotels/motels within a ten minute drive to the site. Please contact them to see if they are dog friendly!

OBSTACLE FAMILIARIZATION / WARM-UP AREA

- There will be no obstacle familiarization.
- A warm-up area will be provided as required by AAC rules. The warm-up area is for the use of dogs that are about to run.

Trial Information

We have a new indoor site. <u>The Soccer Nova Scotia Training Centre (SNSTC)</u> is turfy, rubbery, bright, clean bathrooms, restaurant, places to walk dogs, paved parking, indoor set-up similar to Agridome, except it is entirely covered in turf. So while we will be able to set up on the turf, <u>there will be absolutely no food or water/drinks</u> <u>allowed inside</u>. This includes feeding your dog at ringside and no dog water bowls. There is a viewing/bleacher area on the second floor and there will be room for benching dogs where you can have food and water.

Saturday/Sunday: Set-up times and running orders will be determined after the closing date. Entrants will be notified by email.

Directions:

BMO Soccer Centre - 210 Thomas Raddall Drive, Halifax

From either direction off the 102:

Exit 2A - turn left or right at exit depending on what direction you came from so that you are on Lacewood Drive turning away from Costo. You will go through a few sets of lights. Turn right onto Thomas Raddall Drive. Keep going up the long road/driveway. The building will be on your left.

From Dartmouth:

Take the MacKay Bridge. Exit towards Bedford/Windsor Street. Merge onto the Bedford Highway. Take the Joseph Howe Drive ramp (it is a big hairpin turn). Keep driving along Joseph Howe Drive and take the exit that leads onto the 102. There is a set of lights. Turn right. Take Exit 2A. Turn right onto Lacewood Drive. You will go through a few sets of lights. Turn right onto Thomas Raddall Drive. Keep going up the long road/driveway. The building will be on your left.

Food:

There is a canteen on site but no food is permitted to be eaten on the turf. NO EXCEPTTIONS.
