University College in Arts and Sciences Transition Fellowship

Application Deadline:

Fall Semester	June 16
Spring Semester	November 15
Summer Semester (renewal only)	May 1

Eligibility:

Transition Fellowships are intended to encourage the highly motivated adult student to return to school to continue an education. To qualify, a you must have at least a two-year absence from the college classroom and be admitted to a degree or certificate program in University College for the first time. You must be officially admitted by the scholarship deadline. Awards are competitive, based on evidence of academic achievement and potential, as well as seriousness of purpose.

Transition Fellowships for **undergraduate students** consist of tuition remission for one three-unit University College course and may be renewable for a second University College course taken within two semesters of the original award, if the first course has been successfully completed with a grade of C or better. Students must fill out a renewal form by the deadline.

Transition Fellowships for **graduate students** consist of 50% tuition remission for one three-unit University College graduate course in a student's program. The award may be renewable for a second graduate course taken within two semesters of the original award, if the first course has been successfully complete with a grade of B or higher. Students must fill out a renewal form by the deadline.

You must receive a passing grade in the course the scholarship is applied to.

Washington University employees are not eligible for the Transition Fellowships.
