

I Endorse AB 700, the *California DISCLOSE Act*

Unlimited anonymous special interest spending is subverting our democracy, deceiving voters with misleading ads while hiding who's trying to buy elections. That's why we need the *California DISCLOSE Act*: "**D**emocracy **I**s Strengthened by **C**asting **L**ight **O**n Spending in **E**lections". It will let voters know who *really* is paying for ballot measure ads.

- Requires the top three funders of state and local ballot measure ads to be shown clearly and unambiguously on the ads themselves.
- Requires funders disclosed on ballot measure ads to be the original sources of the contributions to the committee that paid for the ad, even if funders try to hide behind multiple layers of committees or organizations.

Support Statement: *I believe that political ads shouldn't be allowed to deceive voters about who paid for them. I therefore endorse and publicly support AB 700 (Gomez-Levine), the 2015 California DISCLOSE Act.*
