By the time the magnitude of what lies before us begins to dawn upon us, we are embarked; by the time we acquire the navigational skills required for the journey, we are in the midst of it; by the time we realize the precariousness of our situation, we are enveloped in crisis.

We are not insensitive to the fact that today's gospel lesson coincides with the news that thousands of African migrants are making the perilous journey across the Mediterranean in search of asylum; 100,000 have arrived so far in 2015. How many have perished at sea is unknown, but those who have arrived safely have been received on European shores with something less than open arms.

As we sit comfortably in our pews, we too are "crossing over". Our boats are small, the sea is great, and the winds are against us. Finding ourselves with every passing moment further from birth and closer to death, "to be or not to be" is not the question, but how to be.

Thou *who dost still the roaring of the seas*, we do not pray for safe passage, but for skill in navigation; we do not pray for deliverance but direction; we do not pray for calm seas but a calm spirit. Amen.
