The power of forgiveness

When someone wrongs you in some way, do you hold a grudge and keep the hurt? Here are three reasons to embrace the power of forgiveness.

Forgiveness is not something we do for the other person, but something we do for ourselves.



Refusing to forgive merely prolongs hurt feelings. It helps us dwell on them and keep them alive. And that feels awful.

But when you forgive, the negative feelings are purged and there's new

room for goodness. The energy that sustained the anger is now available for other purposes. And that's a much better feeling.

Need another reason? Jesus taught us that to receive daily forgiveness of our own sins we must forgive those who have hurt us. If we can't or won't-how can we obtain it for ourselves?

Think about praying for anyone who hurts you and ask God to bless him. Not only will you find the pain start to lessen, you'll be saying one of Jesus' favorite prayers. He prayed it while on the Cross.

The process by which adults become Catholic

- Are you unbaptized but recognize a need for spirituality in your life?
- Are you a baptized Catholic who never pursued their First Holy Communion and Confirmation because you weren't ready?
- Are you Baptized, received your First Communion but have not received Confirmation?
- Are you baptized into another religion and wish to understand the Catholic way of life and want to become a member of the Catholic Church?

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is the place for you. Every year adults are welcomed into the Catholic Community through RCIA. It is a learning and loving process in which conversion of the heart brings you to Jesus Christ who is our Lord and Savior. "Come to me, all you who are weary and find life burdensome, and I will refresh you. Take my yoke upon your shoulders and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble of heart. Your souls will find rest, for my yoke is easy and my burden light." Matthew 11:28-30.

Over the years at Holy Spirit Parish, many adults have experienced the joy of understanding our Catholic faith and now our process begins again in September. All books are supplied, cost is free and the only thing you bring is the desire to know how Jesus is present in the Catholic Church. Please note - the process is open to all, and if married, must be validly married in the Catholic Church or if you are civilly married outside the Church you must arrange for a Sacramental marriage in the Church or if you were married in the Church, divorced and civilly married another, then your original Marriage Sacrament is still valid and you must seek a Catholic annulment to be married in the Church before starting the RCIA process. Sound confusing, it's not. Talk with us and see how the grace of the Sacraments will fulfill your life.

If you know anyone who wants to become a fully Initiated Catholic (Baptism, Holy Communion & Confirmation) please have them contact Deacon Ray or Fr Kiely. You can leave a message by calling the Rectory @ (914) 737-2316. All candidates must meet with Deacon Ray prior to the start of the RCIA process.




