



**Application For Water Connection
Kensington Water and Pollution Control Corporation**

I wish to make application to have my property connected to the Town of Kensington's central water service system. I understand and agree:

1. that the complete cost for service to connect from the existing curb stop connection into the property is at the customer's expense;
2. that it is prohibited, without the permission of the Kensington Water and Pollution Control Corporation to make or cause to be made, any connection to any pipe or main or to any part of the water system or in any way to obtain or to use water therefrom in any manner other than as set out in the Utility's Rules and Regulations;
3. that it is prohibited to make any installation, equipment or source in such a manner as may allow any contamination to pass from such installation, equipment or source into Kensington's central water supply system;
4. that connection(s) of any customer's installation served by the central water system to any other source of water supply is strictly prohibited;
5. that the existing well or wells on property being serviced to receive central water must be taken out of service before the water supply will be turned on for the customer's access and that any pipe access from the well or wells must be sealed and the well's pump disconnected; and
6. that employees of the Kensington Water and Pollution Control Corporation are the only authorized personnel to turn water on or off at the curb stop and that such employees may, at any reasonable time, have access to inspect connections inside a property to ensure that these regulations have been and continue to be followed..
7. that water connections curb stops are the property of the Kensington Water and Pollution Control Corporation and shall not be covered over or in any other manner tampered with by the property owner or customer.

Failure of the property owner or customer to comply with any regulation of the Water Utility shall be reported to the Kensington Water and Pollution Control Corporation and that such report when verified, shall be justification for the Corporation to suspend the customer's water service and for the Corporation to take legal action to recover the cost of any damage to the central water system and/or to recover the full cost of any liability that has arisen as a result of a prohibited action by the property owner or customer.
