1. Divisions and rules for our tournament are stated and included.
2. League Bowlers and Non-League Bowlers compete in the same divisions.
3. Divisions for each event:
a. Men
b. Women
c. Youth Boy/Girl (Age 20 \& under as of Aug 1, 2015)
4. The tournament manager will have the authority to combine divisions based on the amount of entries \& will be decided prior to the competition.
5. Bowlers that bowl in a current league, regardless of being sanctioned with USBC will be classified as a League Bowler and placed in the League Bowler Category. 6. Bowlers not bowling in a current 2015/16 League, but bowled in a 2014-15 league will be classified as a League Bowler and will use their highest 2014/15 league average.
6. Non-League Bowlers - Bowlers without a book average and not bowling in a current 2015/16 league, will be assigned the following averages; Men -150, Women - 140, and Youth - 130. Handicap will be used from these averages. 8. Average rule: Bowlers will use their 2014/15 bluebook average. If no bluebook average, their current 2015/16 league average will be used, otherwise will be declared a Non-League bowler and will receive the appropriate average.
7. Handicap is $90 \%$ of 210
