

# Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time / September 22, 2013



FROM THE DESK OF FATHER JOHN TOPEL, S.J....

### **Brothers and sisters in Christ:**

"Here comes everybody." I don't know if James Joyce meant that in a disparaging way, or as a compliment, or simply as a statement of fact. The Catholic Church is made up of everybody.

We are the old and the young, the healthy and the sick, the rich and the poor. We are Asian Americans, Afro Americans, European Americans. We are captains of industry and the unemployed. We are Republicans and Democrats. We are traditionalists and progressives. We are extraverts and introverts. You name the flavors and we have it.

Even our sins are varied. Some of us have done jail time; some of us ought to have done jail time. Some of us have engaged in white collar crime, some of us have shoplifted. Some of our sins are sexual, some are blasphemous. Many of us are addicted---to alcohol or drugs, to pornography, to power, to our life-long ideology. None of us has responded as wholeheartedly to the invitation of Jesus Christ to love with our whole hearts, whole soul, whole mind, and whole strength.

The Canadian Jesuit philosopher/theologian Bernard Lonergan wrote that all the human sciences want to study humans as they really are. But only theology can study all humans as they really are---sinners. If we do not admit our sins, then we invent cover stories to hide our sins from others, and, ultimately, even from ourselves. And here is the crucial point: if there is no one who can absolutely and definitive forgive us our sins, then we will not admit that we are sinners. That is the tragedy of atheism---there is no one who can completely forgive us.

And so, the one thing that binds us Catholics together is that we are sinners forgiven and redeemed by Jesus Christ. This is not only our identity, it is also our glory. We Catholics like to glorify ourselves by our strengths, by our purity, by our knowledge. But our real glory is that God has loved us just as we are, as sinners. What we celebrate at each Sunday Mass is this forgiveness poured out on us through the death and resurrection of Jesus.

This relief, the joy of this love, is the bedrock of the good news we want to share with our friends and our "enemies" in the new evangelization. Ponder this and rejoice in it.


