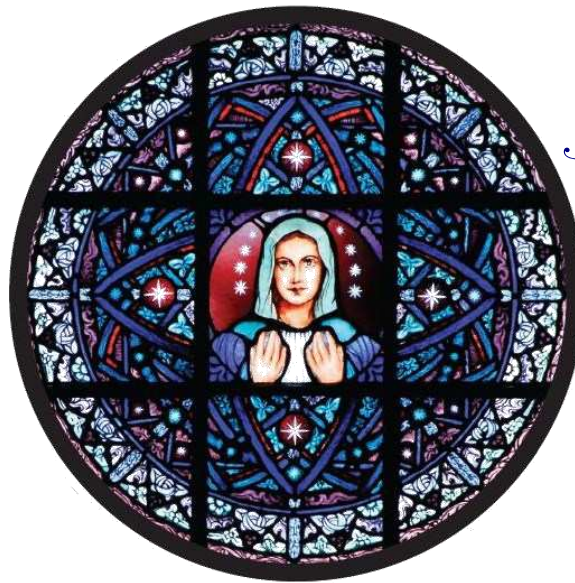

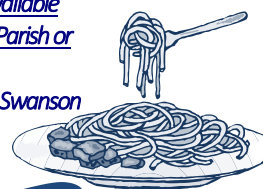
is scheduled for **September 27, 2013**. We are seeking your support for youth programs that include ministries of care, education and outreach to local families in need.

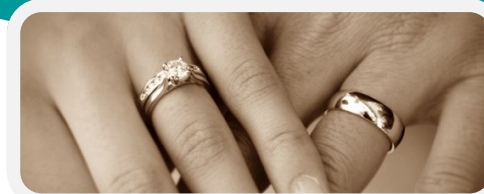
