Fidelity House is a non-profit community center. We offer activities for youth of all ages- such as: Tot Sports Academy, Gymnastics, Arts & Crafts, Inhamural & Instructional sports leagues/clinics, many other programs & special events. We have a School Age Child Care Program from 2:00-6:30PM. This program includes Full Days-holidays, vacation days, 1/2 days & teacher conference days. We provide summer camp programs -Preschool, Kindergarten, Day Camp for 6-13 year olds and sports camps. Our Open Membership offers many great programs for all.

Fidelity House Preschool was established in 1976 as a non-denominational, non-profit preschool for children ages 2.9-5 years. Our school continues to provide a safe and nurturing environment where children are given various opportunities to develop their creative side, interact with peers, build fine and gross motor skills and enhance their self-esteem.

Fidelity House Preschool curriculum is developmentally appropriate and designed to meet needs, interests and ability levels of the individual child. The emphasis is on social skills with the younger children. We combine math and reading readiness with art, music, science & social studies along with free play, especially with the older children. Great importance is placed on reading and storytelling as well.



Open House/Registration begins in January for the following school year. We suggest that you visit the school with your child at this time. Applications are available in the Fidelity House office. Completed forms must be accompanied by a \$75 non-refundable registration fee to reserve a spot for your child.



Tuition payments (9) are due monthly - with the initial confirmation payment starting August 28th and the first of the month thereafter. Preschool starts after Labor Day and follows the Arlington Public School calendar.

Please Note:

Boys and girls who attend preschool on a regular basis adjust more easily, especially at the beginning of the year.

If for any reason your child will be absent, please call the office.

All staff meet or exceed the requirements of Department of Early Education & Care. The staff is comprised of a Director/Lead Teacher, Lead Teachers and Assistant Teachers. All staff members are trained to meet the needs of each child. All faculty regularly attend workshops and seminars to maintain their credentials. We also welcome adult volunteers and student teachers from area colleges.

Communication between home and school is very important. Therefore, teachers are readily available to answer questions and discuss concerns. Parents are encouraged to visit the classroom or volunteer in the room at any time. Formal conferences are scheduled mid-year. Progress reports are given at this time and again at year's end.
