WHO: 3 to 5 year old boys and girls

WHAT: Tee ball is a great way to introduce kids to organized sports. The #1 goal is to have fun, and the children develop some skills too. Practice time before games will focus on throwing, batting and baserunning. Catching and fielding skills will also be introduced. During games, every player will bat and score each inning (the last batter hits a "grand slam"). The defense will field the ball and throw it back to the opposing team's coach.

Each child needs a glove. All other equipment is provided by the league.
