Qualifications and Timeline

A scholarship applicant must:

- Reside in the Greater Houston/Harris County Area.
- Complete and attach all require documentations.
- Graduate from a public, parochial or private secondary school by June 1, 2015.
- Complete and submit application along with letter of recommendations, official transcripts, and essay.
- Provide evidence of admission to a post-secondary college or university, including a junior or community college as well as acceptance of admission.
- Provide documentations of the fall semester enrollment hours with the **college seal prior to** or by August 17, 2015.
- Scholarship Recipients will be notified of acceptance via Email and phone prior to or by August 24, 2015.
