

IGTI Student Scholarship Program

Introduction and Purpose

The International Gas Turbine Institute has a long and proud history of providing scholarships to students in the gas turbine field that show promise and has supplied more than one million dollars over the years. The purpose of these Scholarships is to bring students into the gas turbine field and make them aware of this exciting career field. **The Scholarship is to be used for tuition, books and other University expenses. The check will be made out to the University on the student's behalf.** Student application deadline is May 15, 2013. Scholarship winners will be notified by September 15, 2013. Scholarships will be dispersed in October to the winners.

Student Qualifications

Students must be currently registered at an accredited university (either U.S. or international). The university must have a gas turbine program of some type and only requires that a gas turbine or power course that has significant gas turbine content be offered.
