1. The intending bidder will deposit E.M.D of Rs.45, 000/- in favour of DDO (PHQ) Tihar, New Delhi in form of demand draft/FDR to Prison Head Quarter on or before 11.10.2012 at 11.30AM.
2. The participating firm will physical submit the all documents and DD/ FDR of Rs.45, 000/- mentioned above, duly signed and with seal of the firm, in the required compatible format of the portal.

4. The contractor who will be awarded Lab Tests Tender will submit a security deposit of Rs.1, 50, 000/- in favour of DDO (PHQ) Tihar, New Delhi in forms of Demand Draft/FDR.
5. The amount of security deposit shall be retained by the Department for a period of 60 days after the expiry of tender period as a safeguard against any defect or lack of quality appearing in the items supplied within this period. The contractor shall not be entitled to any interest from the Jail Deptt. for security deposit.
6. The lab should have preferably 24 hours emergency lab testing facility for all the lab tests.
7. Net rate list should be submitted by the laboratory for all tests as per the list attached.
8. While quoting rates of the test, list must be indicated and rates should be quoted in the same serial order as given in the tender list.
9. The participating firms should submit particulars of its working staff and Lab equipments and certification/ registration under government norms. The firms should have NABL Accredited, if any.

10. The firm should be in nearby vicinity of Central Jail Tihar i.e within 5 Km distance. The participating firm should submit its past experience/ list of panel (DHS/CGHS etc.), if any.
11. Sample will be collected by laboratory in routine hours and emergency hours from Central Jail Hospital Tihar & Distt. Jail Rohini on telephonic or written message.
12. The approved firm has to provide disposable items like culture vial/sample collection vials/syringes/needles to Laboratory department. Central Jail Hospital and Distt. Jail Rohini for collecting samples of prisoner patients.
13. The approved firm will not disclose the results of Lab test of prisoner patients to any unauthorized person or to any outsider.
14. Reports should be given within 24 hours except for special test which require more time to be performed. In the case of delay in submission of test reports within stipulated time a penalty of 5% of order value per day maximum of 2 days will be imposed on the approved firm.

AGREEMENT

An agreement made this _____ day of _____, 2012 between M/s. _____ (hereinafter called the ‘Contractor’ which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include his / their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assignees) of the one part and the D.G. (Prisons) (hereinafter called the ‘Jail Department’ which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include his successors in office and assignees) of the other Part.

Whereas, the Jail department has invited tender for Routine & Special Tests in Bio-Chemistry, Pathology & Microbiology (Lab Tests) required for Central Jail Tihar & District Jail Rohini and whereas the contractor submitted the tender which was accepted by the Prison department.

And whereas the contractor, at the request of the Jail department has agreed to Routine & Special Tests in Bio-Chemistry, Pathology & Microbiology (Lab Tests)’ as detailed in the schedule written hereunder (hereinafter called “The said schedule”) at the rates specified against each on the terms and condition hereafter appearing.

NOW THESE PRESENT WITNESSES AND THE PARTIES HERETO HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the contractor has agreed to supply the prescribed standard articles as mentioned in the schedule.
2. That this agreement shall be valid up to one year from the date of award of rate contract. However, the same can be extended up to maximum period of three months at the sole discretion of D.G. (P) and the contractor has to supply the article(s) in the extended period at the same rates quoted in the schedule. Thereafter, the contract can be further extended by the mutual consent of the contractor and D.G. (P).
3. That the contractor shall deposit with this Agreement a sum of Rs. _____ only (Rupees _____ only) in the scheduled bank _____ as Security Money duly placed in favour of D.D.O., Central Jail, Tihar, New Delhi in the prescribed period. The security will be calculated on the value of total items allotted to the suppliers. The contractor will have to pay a security of @ 10% of the total contract.
4. That the rates quoted by the contractor and accepted by the Jail Department include charges such as patent rights, if any, custom duty, octroi, rate of impositions, cost, packing, forwarding, freight, insurance, other taxes, installation, commissioning charges, excise duty, other incidental charges etc. whatsoever payable but excluding Sales Tax/VAT as applicable and showing Sales Tax/VAT separately and free delivery at Central Jail, Tihar, New Delhi & Distt. Jail Rohini, Delhi in respect of supplies.
5. That the Jail department would not be liable to pay any further charges towards any other expenditure incurred by the contractor and any fluctuations in the market and taxes are at the cost of supplier.
6. That the contractor will not disclose the results of Lab test of prisoner patients or nay unauthorized person or to any outsider.
7. Any delay in testing by specific date, time and at place of the testing, beyond the specified schedule, shall render the vendor liable for damage charges at the rate of 5% of the order value per day maximum of 2 days will be imposed on the contractor.
8. In case of any dispute regarding imposition of penalty or forfeiture of security / EMD amount due to late / non-testing, the decision of the D.G. (Prisons) shall be final and binding on the contractor.

9. That the contractor shall intimate the Jail Department the name of the authorized representative who shall come to the jail premises for execution of samples and will get an identity card issued in his name.
10. That the contractor shall submit the monthly bills for comparison with the Accounts Branch and the Stock Register maintained in the office of the RMO, Central Jail Hospital, Central Jail No. 3, Tihar, New Delhi. The payment of the bills will be made to the contractor by the Jail Department and the contractor shall refund any amount overpaid immediately on being informed by the concerned official of the Jail Department.
11. That all disputes are subject to jurisdiction of Delhi Courts only.
12. Any dispute arising out of the tender or any breach of contract, D.G. (Prisons) reserves the right to appoint any person as arbitrator to sort out the dispute. The seat of arbitration will be in Delhi and the decision of arbitrator shall be final at the discretion of DG (P).
13. That the rates offered shall be valid up to one year from the date of award of rate contract. However, the same can be extended up to maximum period of three months at the sole discretion of D.G. (Prisons) and the contractor has to supply the article(s) in the extended period at the same rates quoted in the schedule. Thereafter, the contract can be further extended by the mutual consent of the contractor and D.G. (Prisons).
14. That all the powers exercisable, functions to be discharged in terms and conditions and contents of this deed in relation to the Jail department shall be exercised and discharged by the D.G. (Prisons), Delhi or by other officer so specifically authorized by him in this behalf.
15. That the contractor has agreed to submit an undertaking that he has no personal / official dealings whatsoever with the officers / officials of the Prison department, Delhi.
16. In case any latent defects are detected in due course, the same has to be retesting at the cost of the supplier.
17. That all the disputes and differences arising out of or in a way concerning this first (except those decisions which are otherwise herein above provided for) shall be referred to the sole arbitration of any person nominated by the D.G. (Prisons) of the Union Territory / Govt. of NCT of Delhi or in case his designation is changed or his office is abolished to the sole arbitration of any person(s) nominated by the officer who for the time being, is entrusted, whether, or not in addition to the other functions with the function of the D.G. (Prisons) of the Govt. of NCT of Delhi by whatever, designation on such office may be called.

There will be no objection to any such appointment that the arbitrator so appointed is a Jail Department Servant and that he had to deal with the matters to which this indenture relates and that in the course to his duties as such Jail servant he had expressed view on all or any of matters in disputes of difference. The award of the arbitrator so appointed shall be final and binding on the contractor.

4. Earnest Money deposited by me/us viz. Rs.45,000/- in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft/FDR of Commercial bank in the name of DDO(PHQ), Central Jail, Tihar, New Delhi is attached herewith and shall remain in custody of the D.D.O(PHQ), Central Jail, Tihar, New Delhi till acceptance of the tender is made known.
5. I/we shall forfeit to the D.G.(Prisons) the Earnest Money/Security Money deposited by me/us if any delay occurs on my part/agent of failed to perform the Tests at the appointed place and time of the Tests of the desired quality. The Director General of Prisons, Central Jail, Tihar, New Delhi in that case may get the Tests done from any other source and deduct the extra amount if any paid in connection therewith from the bill submitted by me/us or from the earnest money pending bills/security money deposited by me.
