Dear Families

This coming Monday is ANZAC Day, a day on which we remember and acknowledge the sacrifice of the Australian and New Zealand forces who fought at Gallipoli. The poppies which all of the children made in 2015 for our poppy field have been reused to make the banner in the office. This display is a reminder to all within the school community of the spirit and bravery of these soldiers and the debt we owe to them. Today Mrs lacovino and the Year 6 student leaders represented the school at a special ANZAC Day Ceremony for Schools at the Shrine of Remembrance. Our school captains laid a wreath of poppies, which the children had made, as a sign of our respect.

Next Friday we celebrate the Feast day of Saint Catherine of Siena with Mass at 9:15am. Saint Catherine was born into a large family in Siena, Italy in 1347. She dedicated her life to God and as a teenager joined the Order of St Dominic. This year marks a special time for the Dominican order as they celebrate their 800 Year Jubilee. Saint Catherine stayed faithful to God and her beliefs, even in the face of opposition from those around her. As her holiness and wisdom showed through, many people followed her and the work she did with the sick and the poor. She died in Rome on April 29th in 1380 after a remarkable life, leaving a legacy of outstanding spiritual writing. Saint Catherine was canonised in 1461 and her feast day is celebrated on April 29th. Saint Catherine of Siena, guide and pray for us.

Each year NAPLAN assessments in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 are conducted in schools across Australia. All students will complete the same test on the same day. This year our Year 3 and Year 5 students will participate in these assessments on May 10th, 11th & 12th. These national tests will assess student achievement in both Literacy and Numeracy.

Literacy includes: Reading, Writing and Language Conventions (which is spelling, grammar and punctuation).

Numeracy includes: Number, Algebra, Function and Pattern, Space and Measurement, Chance and Data.

If you have any questions regarding the NAPLAN tests, or about your child sitting these tests, please see your child's classroom teacher. Results from these assessments will be available to parents, in print form, later in the year.

Last Friday we held our PEP Immersion day. This was a fabulous celebration of the culture of many of the countries represented in our school community. A very special thank you to all of the parents who came and participated and assisted on the day. More information about this day will be sent home to all families shortly.

On Tuesday 3rd May we have our 2017 Prep Enrolment Information Night. This evening is primarily for new families, however, all who have children to enrol in 2017 are welcome. Enrolments are open for the month of May and then enrolment interviews will commence. Parents are required to enrol siblings of current children and attend an enrolment interview with their child.

Gum Nuts Required

The Aboriginal Catholic Ministry makes "Aboriginal Rosary Beads" using gum nuts of all sizes. It takes about 100 nuts to make one set of rosary beads and they have orders for hundreds of rosary beads so they need 20-30,000 nuts.

The ministry is looking for people to assist by collecting nuts and also for someone to assist by drying / cleaning / drilling the nuts so they can be used. All sizes of Gum Nuts are acceptable from 30mm diameter down to 10mm diameter.







