The scholarship will be awarded to a student who is seeking admission into one of the following School of Economics coursework master programs:

- Master of Business Economics
- · Master of Development Economics
- Master of Economics and Public Policy
- · Master of Health Economics
- Master of International Economics and Finance

## Eligibility

This scholarship is only open to persons who are Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander. A Certificate of Aboriginality will need to be included in your application. Prior study of economics is not required.

# **Basis of award**

The scholarship is awarded on the basis of undergraduate academic results and relevant work experience. Applicants may be required to attend an interview.

### Application procedure

- 1. Fill in the application form on the next page, and attach your Certificate of Aboriginality
- 2. Attach a covering letter to your application outlining why you wish to study a postgraduate program with the School of Economics, and a brief summary of your work history and how this program will benefit you. You may also wish to include a personal statement of other interests and achievements that you consider relevant to the scholarship selection committee
- 3. Submit your application by the closing date (see page 3 below).
