Rules & Information

1. A bowler with a disability is defined as a person who suffers from a condition that has limitation, restriction or impairment that restricts everyday activity. The condition is permanent. It should be noted that degree or degrees of pain are not considered a disability.

To prove a disability, a participant needs to provide one of the following types of evidence:

- Valid Disability Support Pension Card (DSP).
- Recipient of the Child Disability Allowance.
- Classification Card issued by Tenpin Bowling Australia, Deaf Sports Australia, Blind Sports Australia, Wheelchair Sports Australia or AUSRAPID (or state affiliated organisation).
- Letter from a medical or educational professional:
 - o Physiotherapist or Occupational Therapist.
 - o Principal of Primary, Secondary or Tertiary Education Organisation.
 - o Psychologist.
 - o General Medical Practitioner.
 - o Audiologist.
 - o Ophthalmologist.
- Visual evidence in the case of short statured or participants that are amputees. An amputation is required at the site of a major joint. For example, the loss of a foot or both feet, an arm or both arms.
- 2. All bowlers participating in these championships must be a **TBA Registered Member for 2015** and produce a 2015 Membership Card or proof of payment at check in.
- 3. Each entry must be competed in full, with <u>name</u>, <u>average and grade</u>. Squads have limited numbers so entries will be accepted until full.
- 4. **ENTERING AVERAGES** A bowler's entering average used to determine the grade should be from a minimum of eighteen (18) games bowled in 2015 in a league in a TBA Registered Centre. By entering, the bowler agrees that a centre may be contacted for average verification. The Tournament Director reserves the right to re-grade any bowler prior to, or after the commencement of play. Submitting an incorrect average may result in disqualification. Average is of 30th June 2015
- 5. "ALL EVENT AVERAGE" A bowler's average for Singles will determine the Grade for "All Events".
- 6. "ALL EVENTS" Champion will be declared for each Grade for which a paid "All Events" entry is received. Scores from each bowler's <u>BEST</u> eligible appearance in any 3-person Team or Mixed Team, Doubles or Mixed Doubles and Singles will count towards their "All Event" total. Eligibility for "All Events" is subject to the completion of "All Events" entry form and \$5 payment <u>BEFORE THE FIRST EVENT IS BOWLED</u>.
- 7. SMOKING OR CONSUMING ALCOHOL is prohibited during a session of continuous games during the Championships.
- 8. **DRESS STANDARDS** for all competitors must be neat and tidy. **No tank tops, denim, cargo pants, jeans** or a shirt bearing another bowler's name will be allowed. Shirts may display a sponsor's name. The Tournament Director reserves the right to **postpone or disqualify any bowler with unacceptable attire**.
- 9. **PROTESTS** must be stated verbally to the Tournament Director or designated person, within 15 minutes of the infraction having occurred. The protest must also be lodged in writing to the Tournament Director or representative, within one (1) hour of completion of play of the squad in which the incident occurred.
- 10. VERBAL AND/OR PHYSICAL ABUSE of any person or item of equipment will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification. No bowler, in any grade, division or classification will be exempt from abiding by the TBA National Code of Ethics.
- 11. TIES / TIED POSITIONS will stand, and prizes will be shared.
- 12. A THREE (3) GAME series will be bowled by all bowlers in all Grades and Divisions.
- 13. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION will be as follows:
 - a. **TEAMS**: Bowlers may participate in a maximum of four team entries.
 - The same three (3) bowlers can only participate twice in the same team.
 - b. **DOUBLES**: Maximum of four entries with the same or a different partner.
 - c. SINGLES: Maximum of four entries in their grade or any other grade above their own classification

14. **GRADING** will be based on the entering averages submitted, and allocated in accordance with the **Grading Table**. Otherwise **bowlers will be entered in OPEN GRADE.** Averages to be taken before or on 30th June 2015.
