

MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

The Calgary Bridge Foundation for Youth's Mentorship Program is a school-based program where immigrant students join together to participate in both group and one-on-one mentoring activities at specified school locations. The program consists of three components: Needs Assessment and Referrals; Information and Orientation, which includes Newcomer Orientation and Welcome (NOW) offering orientation and settlement services for high school students and Welcome Information for Newcomers (WIN) offering orientation and settlement services for junior high and elementary school students; and Long-Term Mentorship. The long-term Mentorship component offers Mentorship activities and support for students throughout the school year. The Mentorship Program promotes the positive development of newly arrived immigrant youth by connecting them with peers who are trained to serve as mentors. Weekly meetings are held where students are engaged in activities to help them develop life-skills, and deepen their understanding of Canadian and local school culture. LEARN • EMPOWER • LEAD
