Children & Youth Ministries

I had planned to write something different this week, but there has been an important change in our mission trip plans of which I need to make you aware.

As most of you know, we had planned a youth mission trip to Staten Island, New York this July 6th-13th. However, there has been a request by *Youth on Mission/SCORE International* to help in another location - Morehead City, North Carolina. There is a great need for **Vacation Bible School** teams to serve there this summer.

Because Morehead City is an area heavily dependent on a summer tourist season, many church members must work during the summer and are unable to assist with VBS programs. These churches depend on mission teams to supply the resources and volunteers to reach their community through VBS programs during the summer.

There have been more requests from churches for teams than can be fulfilled this year. There are more and more requests for teams coming in daily! This means that without additional mission teams, churches will NOT be able to have a VBS program for their communities this summer.

Youth on Mission/SCORE International has asked for our church to step up and help SERVE and SHARE the love of Christ! Prayerfully consider joining our mission team to Morehead City, NC this summer. Although NC did not experience Hurricane Sandy as New York did, multiple properties in the vicinity of Morehead City sustained damage when inclement weather struck. So, in addition to VBS, there is a huge need for home repair and construction teams.

The Mission Trip will be during the same week as before, but because the distance has been shortened to one day of travel instead of two, the dates will change to **July 7th-12th** and the initial cost lowered to \$339 (This cost has already been reduced by fund raising). Please be in prayer about this trip because it will still take sacrifice and trust in our Lord!

Continue to claim **Isaiah 9:7** which states, "The zeal of the Lord Almighty will accomplish this." **His will is going to be done!**

We will have more details at the called meeting. In the mean time the color and fabric recommendations are being selected and may or may not be ready at the called conference. The overall project should be passed and you may begin your plans toward giving toward the goal to beautify our worship areas.




