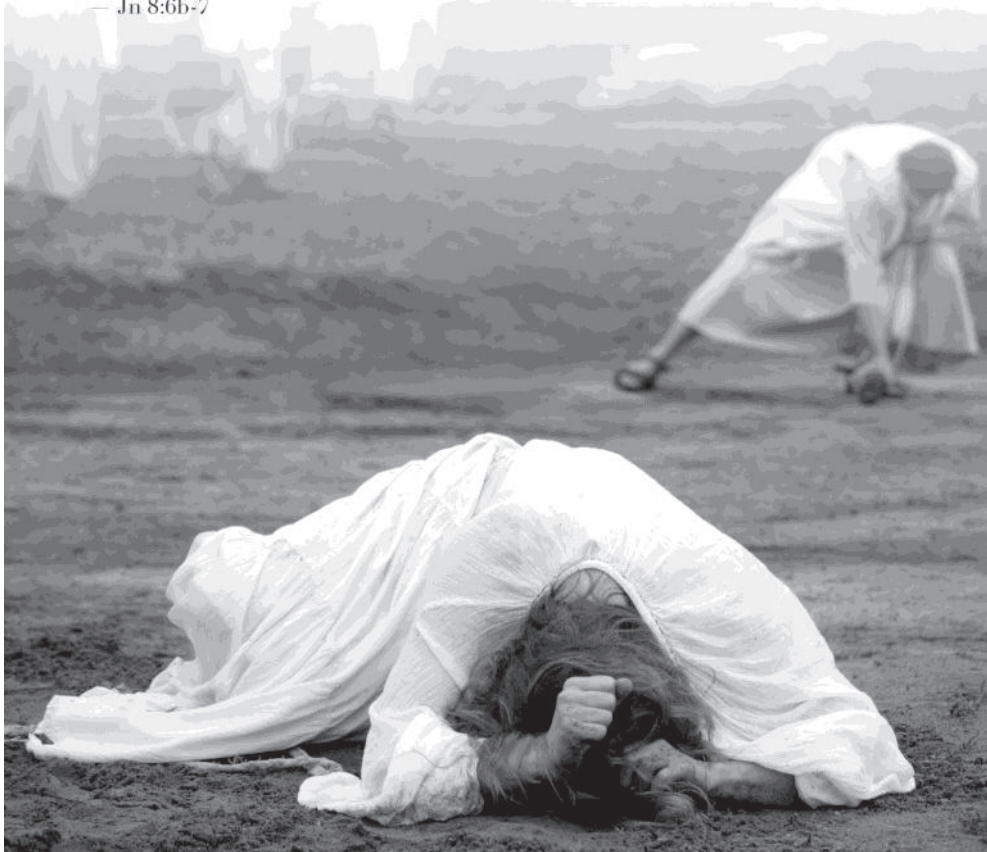

When a family member or you are in the hospital and you wish a pastoral visit, contact Father Michael at the parish office (634-3813) and state the hospital and its location when leaving a message. Also, because of privacy laws, register as a Catholic when entering the hospital; as stated earlier, please call Father Michael to let him know you would like a visit. Please remember that Father Michael is not a mind reader.

Baptism Class : Baptism class is required before a first Baptism. Baptism classes are held in the months of January, April, July and October. Parents are encouraged to attend a Baptism class before the birth of their first child. For questions contact Deacon Frank (634-4394). Preregistration is required.

The Wedding Policy of the Diocese of St. Cloud requires that you contact the parish at least 6 months prior to your wedding. This is necessary so that all the required steps can be completed in a timely manner. For second marriages, more time may be required. To begin your marriage preparation or for questions about the marriage preparation policy, contact Father Michael at the parish office (634-3813).

The First Instruction class in the Billings Ovulation Method – the most effective, modern method of Natural Family Planning – will be offered in Glenwood by appointment at the Sacred Heart Parish Center.
