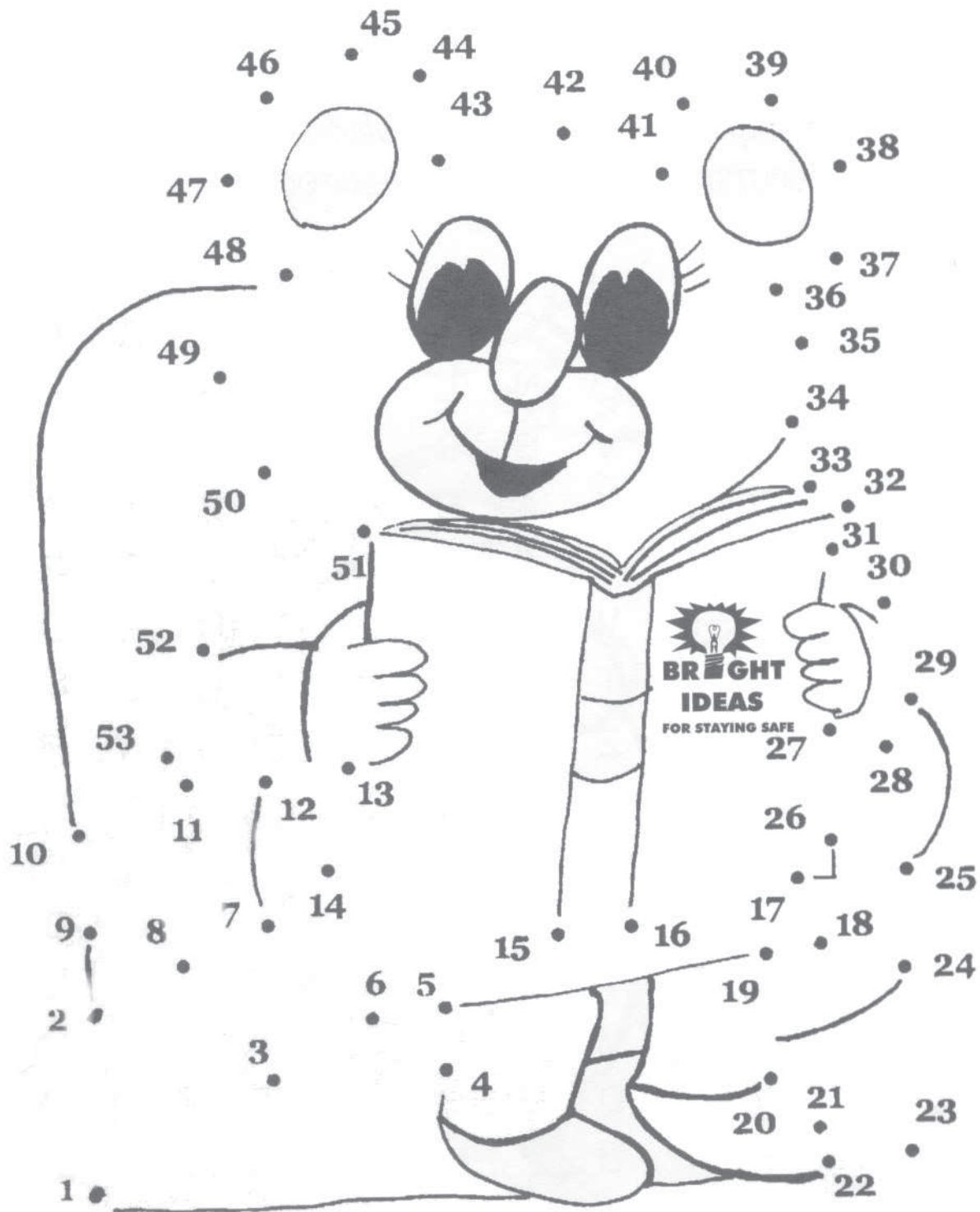

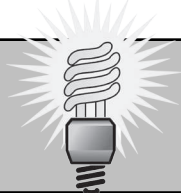

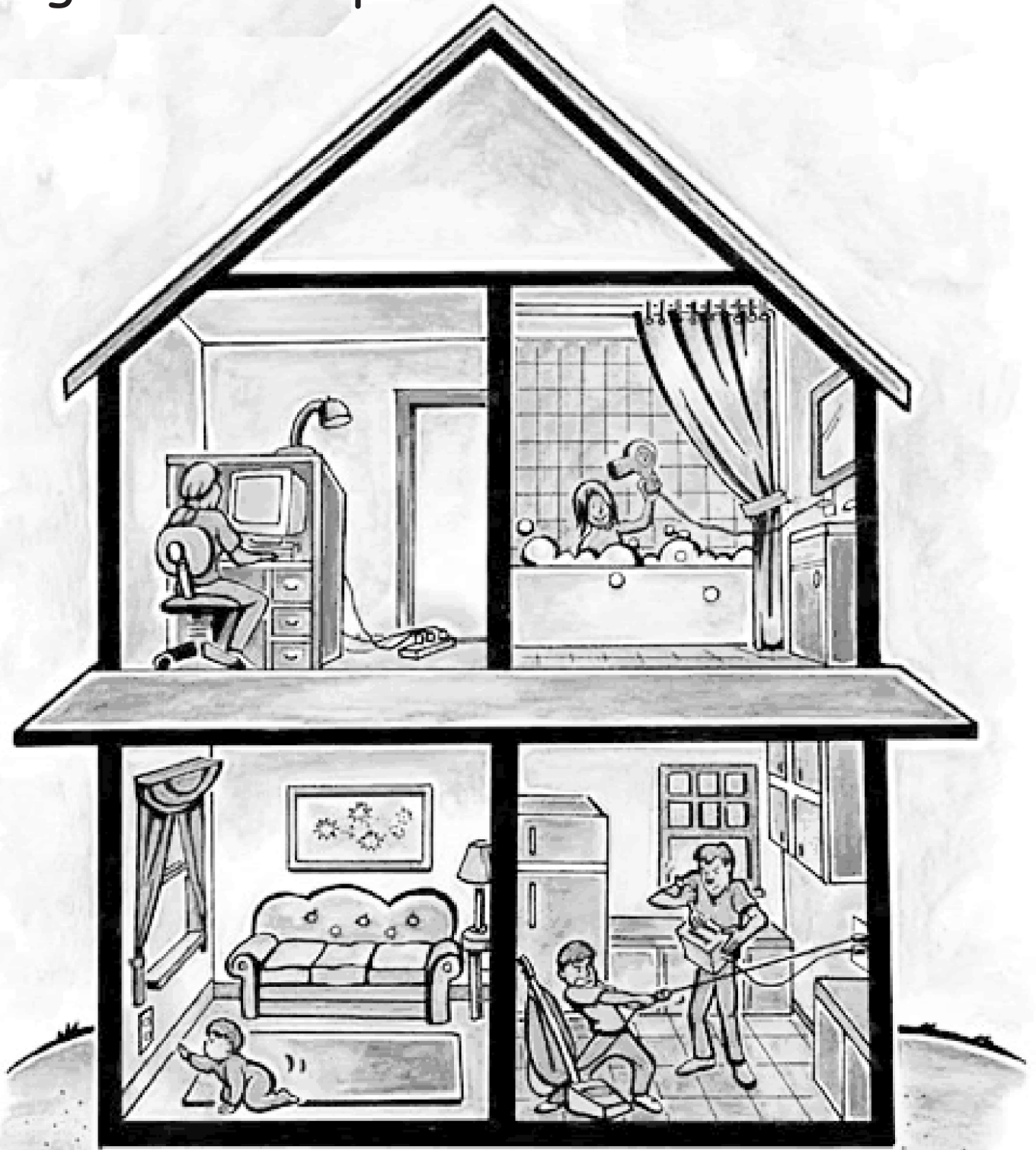

Can you find three ways people can waste energy and two ways people save energy in this picture?



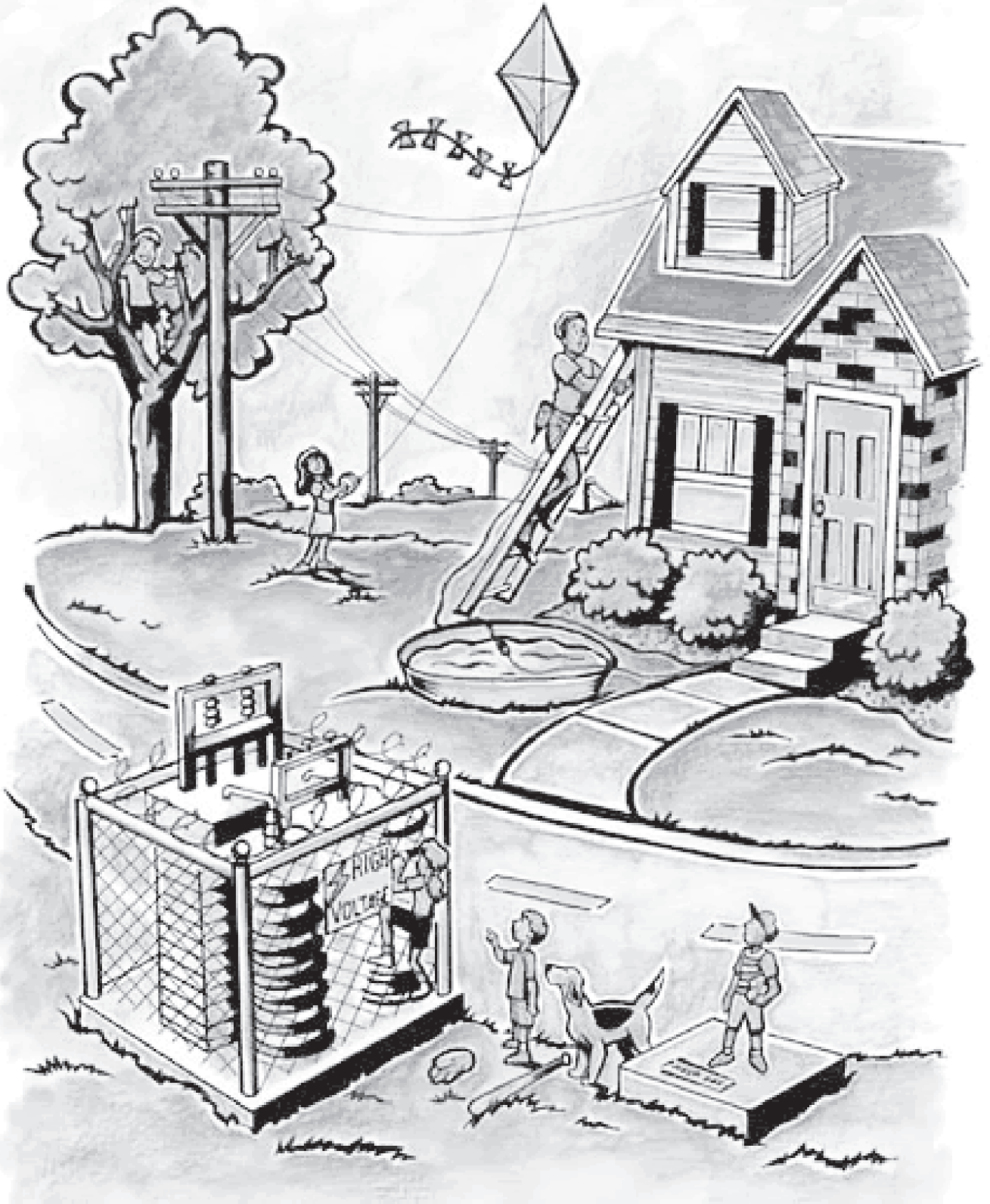
Energy Wasters - 1. leaving lights & TV on when no one is around 2. Leaving door open lets cooled or heated air out 3. Leaving refrigerator door open.

Can you find five indoor electrical safety dangers in the picture below?



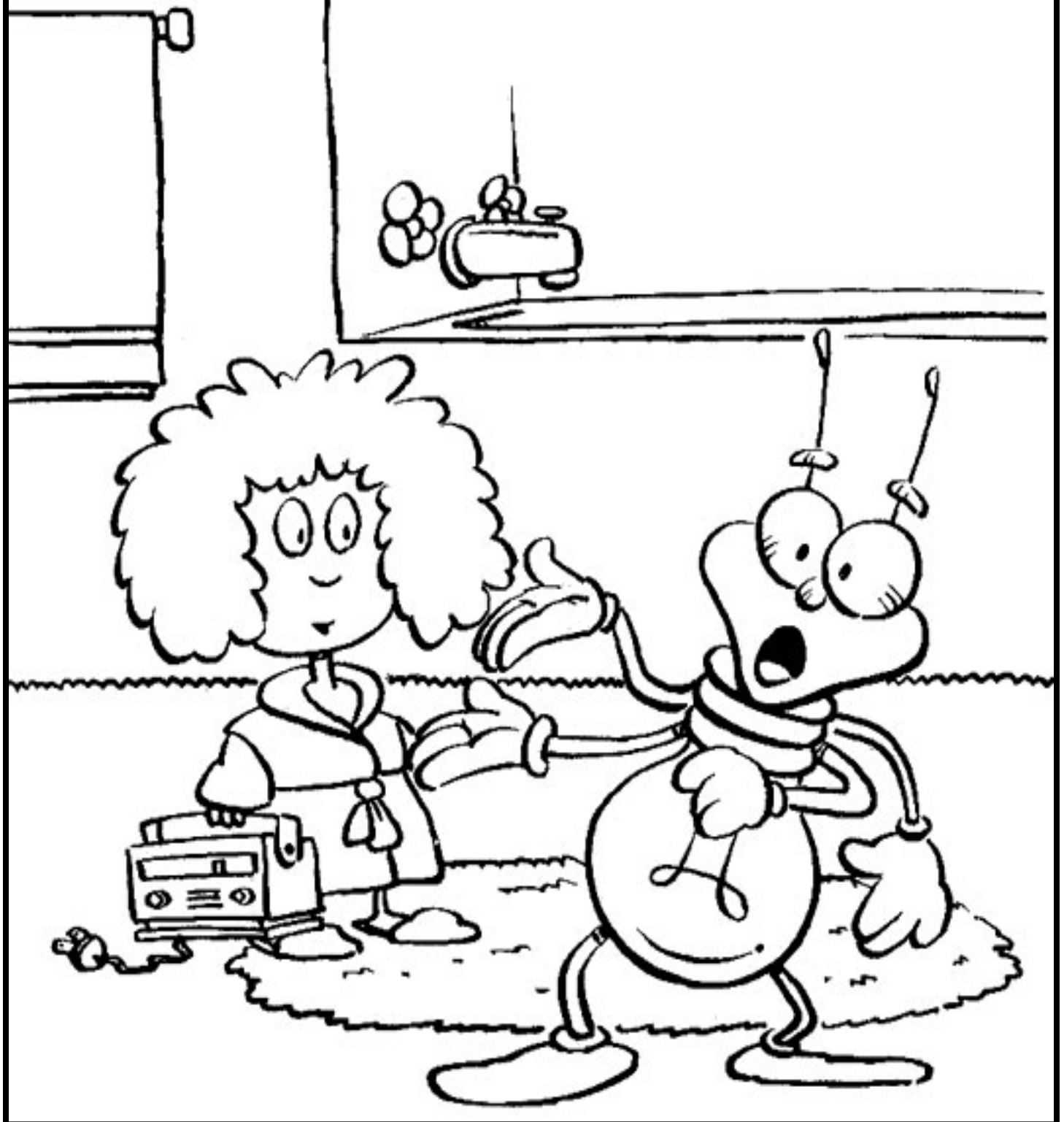
1. Don't have too many things plugged into an extension cord.

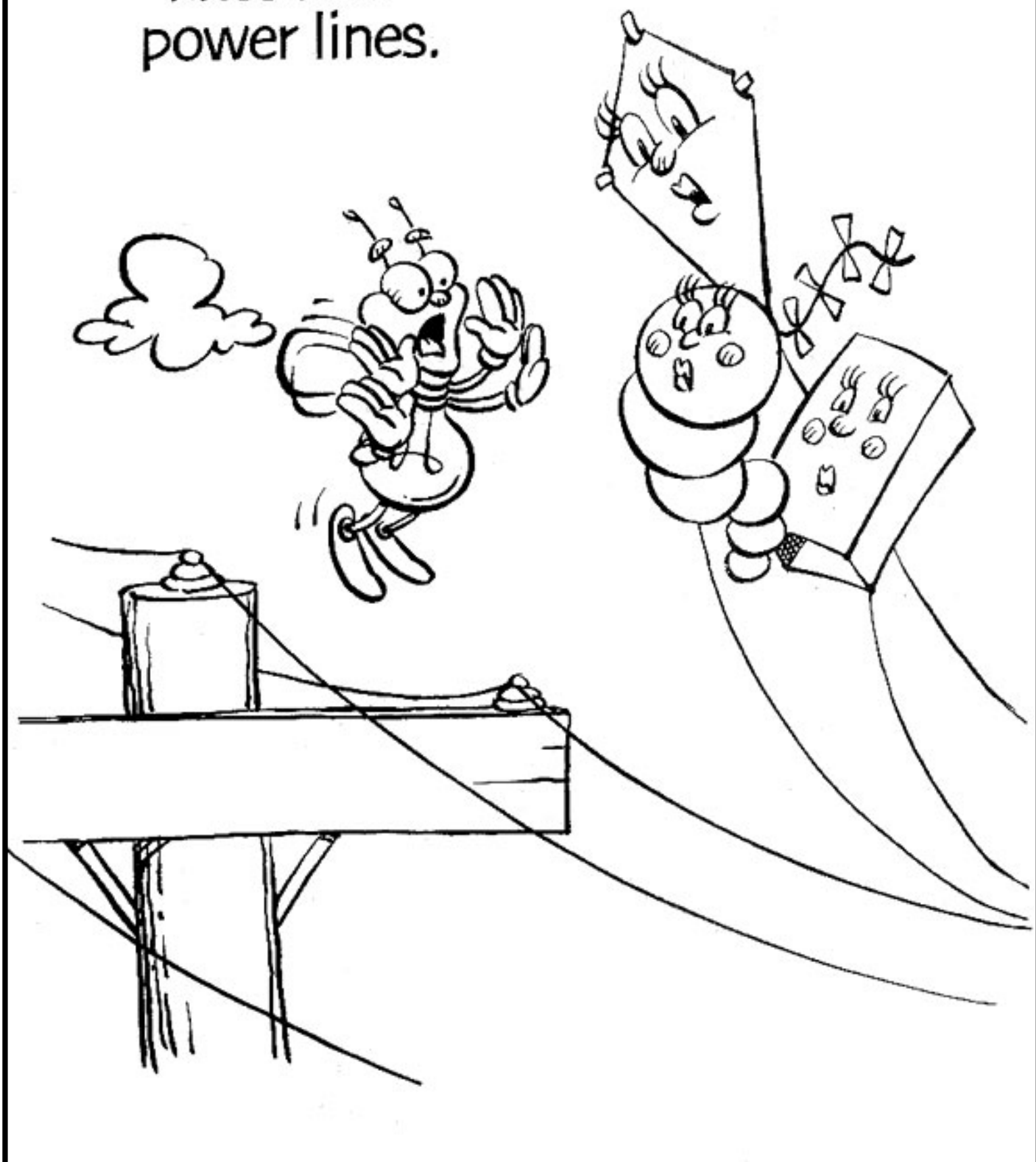

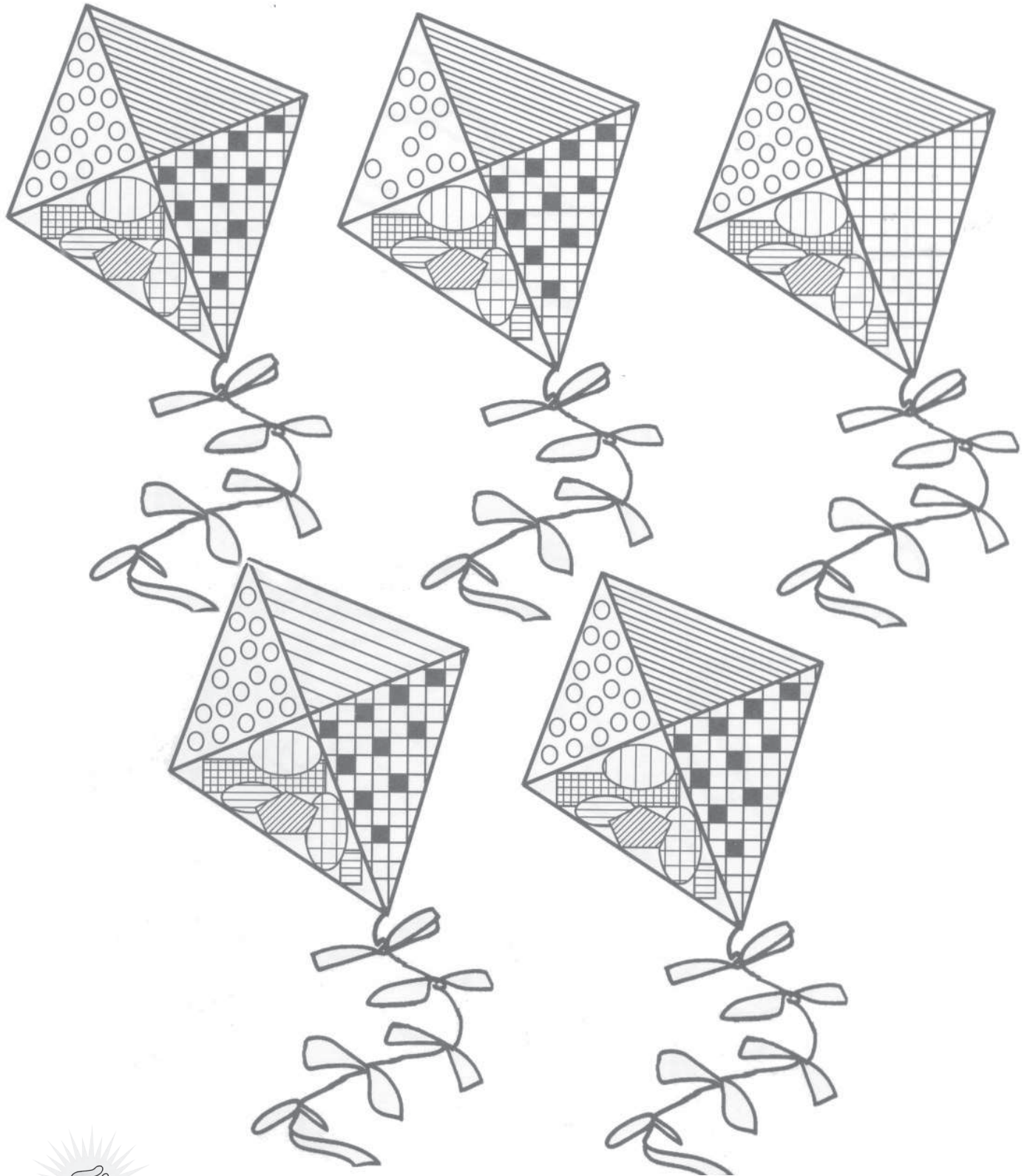


Overloaded outlets can cause fires. Find another outlet or use a power strip.

Don't overload electrical outlets with too many appliances.



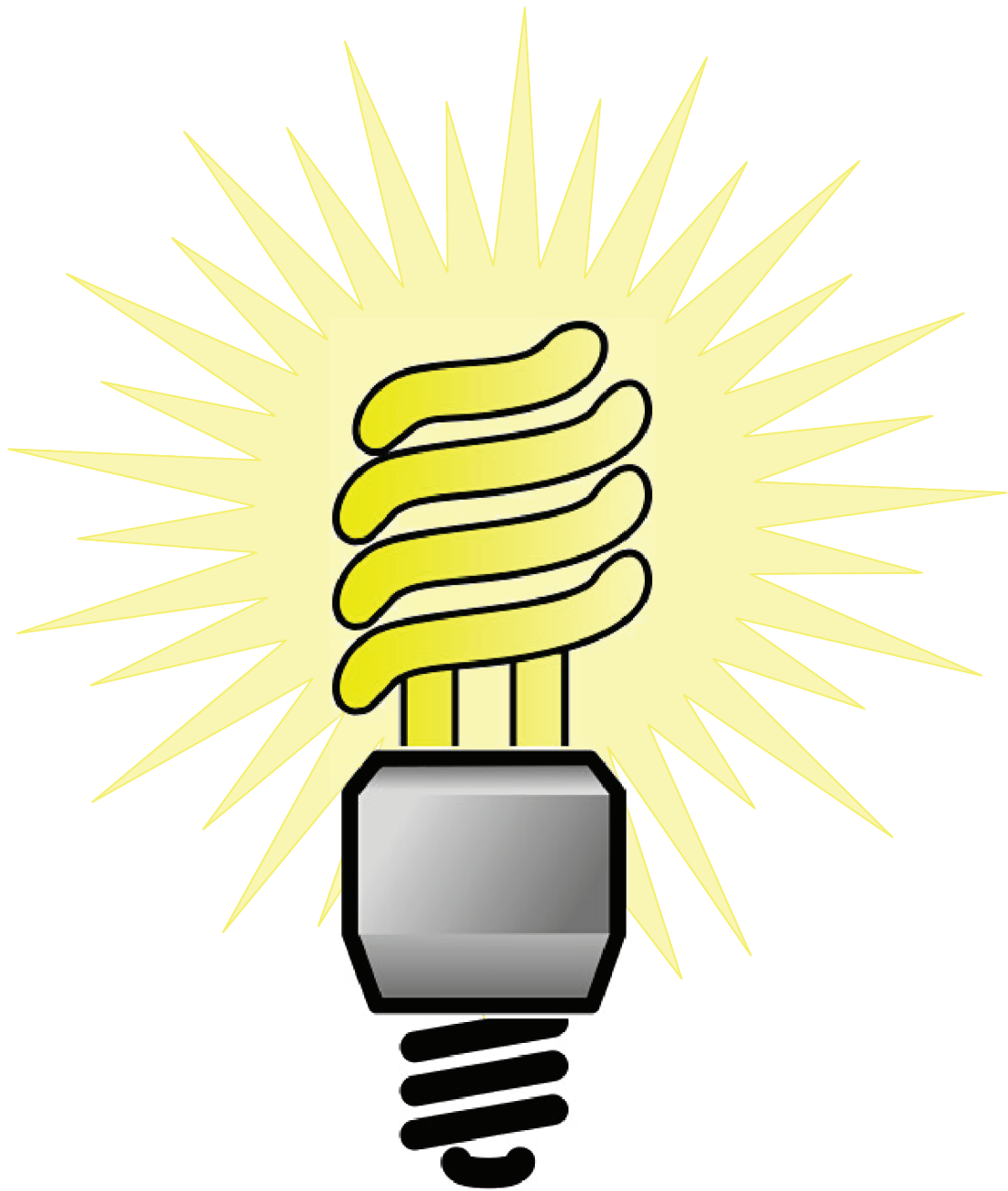
Stay away from places that have Danger: High Voltage signs and keep your friends away too.
