

"Helicopters and Hoverboards: Challenges & Opportunities of Parenting in the 21st Century."

It seems that today's parents continually struggle to find the right balance between support/nurturance and fostering independence. In a culture where we hear the terms "Helicopter Parenting" and "Overparenting," many wonder if they are striking the appropriate balance of support and empowerment, while remaining true to their personal values and hopes for their children. She regularly presents in various local Dioceses addressing the challenges families face in the 21st century and how to apply mindful techniques to help families stay connected.

We heard the last part of the Second Reading at the Christmas Mass at Dawn; now on this feast we focus on the "bath of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit" that Christ "poured out on us". We learn that our own Baptism trains us "to reject godless ways and worldly desires and to live temperately, justly and devoutly." In Luke's account of Jesus' baptism, John makes a distinction between the baptism he performs, a baptism for repentance, and the one Jesus will give, the one we received for transformation and mission. In the Gospel, we also hear the Father's joyful affirmation of his Son as "beloved", something we may not remember hearing at our own Baptism. As the Christmas decorations are packed away for another year, now is a good time to listen to those words again and claim them.
