ITINERARY:

Sun, Sep 29th: Newark/London - Depart on your overnight flight to London. Dinner served in flight.

Mon, Sep 30th: London/Harwich - Upon arrival in *London,* we are transferred to *Harwich* to board our cruise ship the *Celebrity Infinity.* Spend the day exploring Harwich. Our ship sets sail at 5:00PM. Join your friends on deck for the sailing! Our cruise will sail to some of the most popular wine regions in Europe. While on board, you will experience these wines and in port you will have the option to book some of the wine tours.



Tue, Oct 1st: Le Harve, France - Included Tour of Normandy Landing Beaches & Lisieux Arrival in the Port of *Le Harve, France* at 7:00 AM. After breakfast, we depart to the *Normandy Landing Beaches.* Today we take a poignant, memorable day trip, to the Normandy battlefields and landing beaches of World War II. You'll visit famous wartime sites and the American Cemetery, spend time on the historic beaches and gain invaluable insights into the wartime experience of the Allied soldiers and the French citizens they liberated. Enjoy the picturesque Normandy countryside. We stop at Ste. Mére Eglise where Private John Steele's parachute caught on the steeple of the church. The wounded paratrooper hung there limply for two hours, pretending to be dead, before the Germans took him prisoner. After lunch (on our own) at the Roosevelt Café on Utah Beach, we visit Pointe du Hoc, a German defense position that was heroically taken by US soldiers. Continue to the American Cemetery of Saint-Laurent, the final resting place of almost 10,000 soldiers.

Feast Day of St. Therese of Lisieux



After our tour of Normandy, we visit *Lisieux*, town of *St. Therese of Lisieux*, patroness of our *Little Flower Pilgrimages*. Today is her Feast Day and we celebrate it by visiting the *Basilica of St. Therese of the Child Jesus* where we see *relics* of St. Therese and *the Carmel* where St. Therese spent her short, but holy, life as a nun.

Wed, Oct 2nd: Le Harve - Free day to enjoy Normandy or to take one of the optional tours to Paris that will be offered on board. The allure and romance of Paris are legendary. This capital city of France is home to innumerable museums, such as the Louvre, Musée d'Orsay, Musée Picasso and Musée Rodin, parks and gardens, including the Tuileries Garden on the banks of the Seine and the Left Bank Luxembourg Garden, as well as monuments such as the Eiffel Tower and the Arc de Triomphe.

Thu, Oct 3rd: At Sea Cellar Masters - Immerse yourself in the culture of wine within the inviting atmosphere of Cellar Masters, the famous wine bar. Cellar Masters offers you the opportunity to try a bold collection of both familiar and unknown wines from around the world. Fri, Oct 4th: Bordeaux, France - Morning arrival in the port of *Le Verdon,* one of the ports of Bordeaux. Today take advantage of one of the Optional Tours. Or visit the lovely town of Soulac-sur-mer near Le Verdon.

Sat, Oct 5th: Bordeaux, France - Today enjoy the activities onboard or join one of the optional tours to a winery. Our ship departs at 6:00 PM.



Sun, Oct 6th: Bilbao, Spain - Included Tour of Lourdes - Arrival in *Bilbao, Spain* at 7:00 AM. After breakfast, we depart to *Lourdes.* We spend the day visiting the *Basilica and Grotto,* take the *Baths* and take part in the *Blessing of the Sick*. We join the *Candlelight Procession* before our return to our cruise ship.

Mon, Oct 7th: Bilbao, Spain - Today enjoy shopping in this jet set port. Our ship departs at 3:00 PM.



Tue, Oct 8th: Vigo, Spain - Included Tour to Santiago de Compostela - Arrival in *Vigo, Spain* at 12 noon. Upon arrival we are met by our driver and guide for our tour of Santiago de Compostela. Our ship departs at 8:00 PM.

Santiago's name and fame both derive from Saint James the Apostle (Sant Iago), whose holy relics are enshrined under the cathedral's altar. Legend has it that James preached in Spain before being martyred in Jerusalem in 44 AD and his body was brought back to Spain after his death. The tomb of St. James was discovered here in 819 AD and a small church was soon built over the shrine by the king.

The present Santiago Cathedral, an impressive Romanesque structure with a Baroque facade, was begun in 1078 after the previous church was destroyed by Moorish invaders. A thriving town soon developed around the cathedral and Santiago became a major pilgrimage destination, surpassed only by Jerusalem and Rome. Devout pilgrims traveled long distances along the Camino de Santiago ("Route of St. James"), a series of pilgrimage roads throughout France and Spain, to pray at the tomb of St. James and gain religious merit.

Over the last century, newer pilgrimage sites like Fatima and Lourdes have surpassed Santiago in popularity, but many devout Catholics still make the trek to pay their respects to St. James. In addition, Santiago's magnificent cathedral, medieval buildings, and charming streets draw thousands of tourists each year. Many modern travelers to Santiago, both religious and nonreligious, choose to reach the holy city by walking, biking, or riding horseback on the paths of the historic Camino de Santiago.



Wed, Oct 9th: Porto, Portugal - Included Tour of Fatima - Arrival in *Porto, Portugal* at 7:00 AM. After breakfast, we board our bus for *Fatima.* Upon arrival we visit the Chapel of Apparitions, the Chapel of Adoration and the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary where we see the Tombs of Sr. Lucia and Blessed Jacinta and Francisco. We return to our ship for our 6:00 PM departure.

Thu, Oct 10th: At Sea - **Tuscan Grille -** Perhaps this evening visit an Italian steakhouse with a nouveau twist. An outgoing wait staff ensures tableside service that's personal as well as professional. Take the traditional style and artisanal flair of Italy, add contemporary influences, and serve the cuisine in abundance. It's all part of the expansive character of Tuscan Grille. (There is an additional fee for this restaurant.)

Fri, Oct 11th: At Sea - Enjoy your last day at sea. Visit the Casino, play some games or just lay by the pool.



Sat, Oct 12th: Harwich/London Panorama

Morning arrival in Harwich and disembarkation. We are met by our driver and transferred to London. On arrival in London we have a panoramic drive around Parliament Square to Westminster Abbey, where many of England's kings, queens, statesmen, poets and writers are buried. Next we see Big Ben and the neo-Gothic Houses of Parliament, Whitehall, Downing Street and Trafalgar Square, watched over by Nelson's Column. We continue passed Buckingham Palace. We pass the Tower of London, the ancient fortress steeped in centuries of murder and treason, guarded by jet-black ravens. The Tower of London is home to the priceless "Crown Jewels", including the enormous Cullinan diamonds and the extraordinary Koh-i-Noor.

Sun, Oct 13th: Norwich/London Panorama/USA - Morning departure to Heathrow Airport for our return flight to the USA.
