Planning for 2015

I thank all those who promptly returned the 'Returning to Galilee in 2015' form, informing us of your intentions for 2015. We are very close to being full in 2015 therefore, families must let us know of any changes, as there is a waiting list. You are required to give a full terms notice to avoid being charged the proceeding terms fees, including the beginning of a new year. If you did not return the form, please do so.

Planning for 2015 is underway, including staffing and home group structures. This can be a challenging time for all involved, due to the unknown nature of the process. To help make this time less challenging I ask the community to be patient and aware of other people's feelings and situations. I have provided some information to help below.

Staffing

We are currently in the process of making decisions regarding staffing. I ask parents not to ask staff about 2015, as you are putting teachers in a difficult situation. When final decisions and positions are in place the community will be informed. Please be considerate that this can be an anxious time for staff, parents and students so we ask for your patience in this matter.

Home group placements

Placement of students in home groups will occur over the coming weeks. This is a challenging process and we make decisions on many factors. When placing students, staff consider academic, social and wellbeing needs of individuals and importantly how the students will function together as a learning group. If parents have specific information regarding a child's placement it must be provided in writing (or email) via the office by the Monday 27th October. I will only accept information regarding student learning, social and wellbeing needs. Requests regarding staffing will not be considered. I remind you that information you provide is a <u>request</u> that will assist us in decisions.

Term 4 is always a busy term and remind you to check diary dates for events, excursions and celebrations.

- 3. Walk bikes, scooters and skateboards across the crossing.

Constructing, Respecting, Welcoming

Q Will the school be closing early this term?

A Yes. Due to WHS staff training, the school will be closing at 2.30pm, Tuesday, 11th November. Please mark this date in your diary.

Q What are there times for locking and unlocking the school gates?

A Each morning the gates will be locked at 8.55am by the staff member returning from the car park. Each afternoon the gates will be unlocked at **2.55pm**. You are most welcome to enter and exit via the front office and deck should you be engaging in special activities such as a sharing afternoon, afternoon prayer, listening to reading and so on.

Q Where is the Lost Property located?
