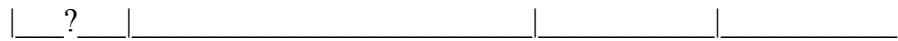

1. 70-100 AD—The Gospels and ancient classical texts
 2. 55 AD—Approximate date, writing of 1 Corinthians

 5. 48 AD—Paul’s later visit to Jerusalem
 6. 30-35 AD—The apostolic message before Paul, according to skeptics
