Overview

OSRconnect, an online lodgement and payment system for duties (including payroll tax and transfer duty), requires practitioners to assume the responsibility of self-assessment. However practitioners may not understand the risks and exposure of incorrect self-assessments or failure to adhere to the required procedures.

This practical session will provide you with valuable insight into these procedures. It will also assist you to navigate the technical provisions of the *Duties Act* 2001 to mitigate such exposure without compromising your obligations to act in the best interests of the client.
