## Student's Name

- 1. Be courteous and polite
  - A. Be a good team member; share and take turns
  - B. Be a good listener; follow directions

  - E. Do not pick plants; stay on the trails; respect wildlife
  - F. Do not fight or use inappropriate language
- 2. Be committed

  - A. Walk
  - B. Stay on established trails

- 4. Leave these items at home
  - A Food, gum, candy
  - B. Money and valuables

  - D. Curling irons and makeup
  - E. Anything which could cause injury to you or another person (e.g., knives, razors, or drugs)
  - F. Any items not allowed at your school

## **Implementation of Standards**

- 1. Students review standards with their parents and with their teacher.
- 2. Failure to follow standards set at Outdoor Science School will result in the following :
  - A. A conference will be held with the student.
  - B. If problems continue, the student will be removed from an activity.
  - C. If the problem is not resolved, a phone conference will be held with the program manager and the parent or guardian.
  - D. If the problem is still not resolved, the parent will be required to take the student home.
