Behavior Standards

1. Be courteous and polite
 - A. Be a good team member; share and take turns
 - B. Be a good listener; follow directions
 - C. Share in the work; show good sportsmanship
 - D. Respect others and be considerate of others' belongings
 - E. Do not pick plants; stay on the trails; respect wildlife
 - F. Do not fight or use inappropriate language
2. Be committed
 - A. Plan to stay the entire time, if possible
 - B. Participate in the lessons and activities
3. Follow Outdoor Science School safety rules
 - A. Walk
 - B. Stay on established trails
 - C. Stay with your supervising adult and the group
 - D. Do not throw objects (rocks, snow, sticks, etc.)
 - E. Do not carry walking sticks on trails
4. Leave these items at home
 - A. Food, gum, candy
 - B. Money and valuables
 - C. Cell phones, radios, electronic games, mp3 players etc.
 - D. Curling irons and makeup
 - E. Anything which could cause injury to you or another person (e.g., knives, razors, or drugs)
 - F. Any items not allowed at your school

Implementation of Standards

1. Students review standards with their parents and with their teacher.
2. Failure to follow standards set at Outdoor Science School will result in the following :
 - A. A conference will be held with the student.
 - B. If problems continue, the student will be removed from an activity.
 - C. If the problem is not resolved, a phone conference will be held with the program manager and the parent or guardian.
 - D. If the problem is still not resolved, the parent will be required to take the student home.
