Students in Year 5 and 6 are being provided with the opportunity to participate in an upcoming orienteering gala day on Wednesday, May 22 at Croome Road Sporting Complex.

The event will be run by Orienteering NSW with age appropriate courses designed to cater for students of all experience levels. There will be Orienteering NSW officials and coaches present on the day to guide students through successful completion of the courses. Students do not need to have participated in orienteering previously in order to attend.

Where: Croome Road Sporting Complex, Albion Park

Cost: \$8

Transport: Travel will be by private transport. Parents will need to arrange for their child to arrive for a 9.30am start and be picked up at the finish time of 2.30pm.

What to bring: Food, water, sunscreen, hat, a tarp or rug to sit on. Closed shoes are essential. In the event of wet weather, students should bring a raincoat and spare set of clothes.
