Dress Code

Dress for the weather. Rain, shine or cold. Always be prepared with a rain coat or jacket when going fishing and rain is in the forecast. Bring jacket when cold. The temperature around water tends to be cooler than off water areas especially with wind blowing.

Please

- Review club and tournament rules
- No pre-fishing permitted 24 hours before the start time of a tournament at that location
- Make sure your equipment is in good working order
- No friends or siblings (we cannot can be responsible for them)
- You must let advisors know if you leave early or you will have a penalty at next event.
- Must have parent's signature on page one and hand it in.
- Bass must be 14" in length to count as measuring standard of ODNR

Special notes:

-We will be fishing 8:00 to 4:00

- Everyone must be there by 7:30 so we can figure pairings and load up the boats.

-Maximum 3 persons to a boat.

-5 fish limit 14" in length for the Hawgs.

-The boat captain's will also compete.

-Each boat captain will weigh 1 fish of his own (his big bass) and combine that with the weight of his youth angler for his total weight.

-If a captain has more than one youth angler, they will use the largest weight from one of their youth anglers.

-All Hawgs are required to wear a life jacket at all times they are in a boat for this tournament.

-No Hawgs are permitted to operate the large motor but are allowed to operate the trolling motor at the discretion of the boat captains.

-No one is to weigh a fish caught by another angler or parent.

-No live bait!
