Workshop Descriptions

#1: Karen Bonnell/Maureen Conroyd/Loretta Story/Mark Weiss – Introducing the new Parenting Plan Worksheet How the child specialist, coach, and lawyers can effectively work together using the King County Collaborative Law Parenting Plan Worksheet.

#2: Jamie Kautz – Destructive Narcissism

Frustration, anger, turmoil, guilt. These are just a few of the descriptions people give when they are involved in cases with clients who struggle with destructive narcissism (DN). This session will help professionals understand, identify, and learn to more effectively manage DN in the collaborative process.

#3: Sevilla Rhoads – Mindful Lawyering: Practical Skills to Improve Quality of Legal Services, Increase Professionalism, and Benefit Lawyer Wellbeing.

Neuroscience indicates mindfulness can assist us in understanding and harnessing the potential of our minds. A growing number of lawyers and judges across the nation are exploring and applying mindfulness to their work. Sevilla will provide an introduction to mindfulness and offer practical tools for its use in your legal practice.

#4: Susan Gamache - How's Your Team IQ?

How is your Team IQ? Do things move too slowly? Work relationships difficult? Are you misunderstood? This workshop will help you increase your Team IQ and have more productive and enjoyable relationships with your CP colleagues. In CP, we are only as good as our working relationships. You can increase safety and aviod defensiveness. Roughly 85% of conflict is unwarranted – learn to tell the difference!

#5: Karen Bonnell/Rachel Felbeck/Felicia Malsby - Beyond Collaborative: Where Collaborative Principles Inform Dispute Resolution Alternatives

Collaborative practitioners are seeking new ways to embody the values and skills of the collaborative law model while altering specific areas of the model to meet the needs of the clients. This workshop will review some practices being utilized and provide suggestions for adjustments to the collaborative model based on client needs and resources.

#6: Billie Grissom/Kevin Scudder - Best Practices

From intake to entry of agreed final pleadings, what have collaborative professionals found to be "best practice" for conducting a collaborative family law case.
