7. Sycamore Creek CFD #1.

- a. Project Update Steve Stout that sales for February were 12 but 7 cancelled leaving them with 5 for the month. Steve also reported the Phases 7 & 9 would be multi-family with 180 units. Fieldstone intends on starting the commercial area in June, they are still working with the County on the park area. ChlorTech will finish the reservoir tank repairs.
- b. 1526 houses to be built. 904 houses occupied to date. 59% complete.

8. Empire Capital "The Retreat CFD #3".

- a. Project Update Lee Dotson reported that Empire is working with Superior Tank on recoating the reservoir. He also reported that Empire is still working on wells completion and the sewer lift station is almost complete. Lee reported that the development would have 2-two story commercial buildings. The Knabe Road street improvements are still with the County for review.

9. KB Home "Painted Hills" Project.
