The "Z BLOG" Crime Prevention Tip of the Month

This month's crime prevention tip focuses on domestic abuse. Below are potential indicators of domestic abuse for women and children. These are just common indicators and are not the only indicators.

Potential Indicators Of Domestic Abuse

Woman: In general, women who are abused physically are often isolated. Their partners tend to control their lives to a great extent as well as verbally degrade them. Some examples are as follows:

- The woman mentions not being able to use the phone
- She is forbidden from seeing friends unless he is along
- The man has exclusive control over all money and household financial matters
- She is not allowed in the decision making process at home Children: (Primarily boys) often show signs that his parents are domestically violent.
- Serious problems with temper tantrums
- Continual fighting at school or between siblings
- Lashing out at objects, inside or outside of the home
- Treating pets cruelly or abusively
- Threatening younger sister or brother with violence for instance, "You better play with me or I'll kill you. I'll slice you

With a knife"

Attempting to get attention through hitting, kicking or choking

Modeling after dad "Monkey see, monkey do"

Look for these possible indicators for domestic violence. If someone you know is being abused, they may show one or more of these signs:




Job Well Done

W hat is the Pearland Citizens Police Academy?

The original concept of the Citizens Police Academy (CPA) came from Great Britain, where the UK Constabulary designed a program to give citizens an overview of British law enforcement operations. Known as "police night school" when it began in 1977, the program was an immediate success.

The idea spread to the United States via the Orlando (Florida) Police Department soon thereafter. The CPA concept can now be found in large and small law enforcement agencies across the USA and Canada.

The Pearland CPA is a free community oriented policing program designed for citizens of Pearland. The program is conducted twice a year at the Pearland Police Department and has three goals in mind:

- 1. To allow citizens of Pearland to meet the men and women who serve them.
- 2. To educate citizens in the "how's" and "why's" of Law Enforcement.
- 3. To provide Pearland Police Officers the opportunity to meet and hear from the citizens they serve.

CPA Students are encouraged to be involved in the instruction by using the "two way lectern" approach during the course. The City of Pearland and the Pearland Police Department encourage input from citizens.



Who Can Attend the CPA?

The CPA is open to all residents that live or work in the Pearland area. Applicants are subject to a small background check to ensure the integrity of the program.

A minimum age requirement of 18 years is imposed with the exception of 17 if attending with a family member.

The CPA class is held twice a year, once in the spring and once in the fall. CPA Class 29 will start on August 6th, 2009. The class meets regularly on Thursday nights from 7 PM to 10 PM. Visit www.pearlandpd.com to register for the upcoming class.


