Report

Last Saturday the 20th February had the running of the second TPVRC Night Shoot for the 2016 calendar year where there were some changes to the target and the addition of a new class.

New targets customized with a highlighted 'X' and 10 ring were trialed as well as the new 14 power scope class that separates the lower power scopes from the higher was introduced. This new class allows more flexibility for the members to test themselves by winding down their scope power and also for those members with lower scope powers to not be disadvantaged.

All reports is both new introductions were well received and given the thumbs up from the members.

The course of fire didn't change where 4 x targets were shot on in two details with each target being out of a possible 50.5. The targets are then scored for a grand aggregate out of a possible 200.20. Top three group sizes are also acknowledged.

Peter Barnier was definitely dialed in on the night shooting a 197.02 which included two 'possible' targets of 50.0 and 50.01. This is also the highest score shot in the night shoots since going to the reduced centre targets. Peter also shot the smallest group on the night registering a 1 ½ inch group.

Other group sizes were Max Collins with a 1-5/8 inch group and then Michaela Ekman with a 1- 11/16 inch group.

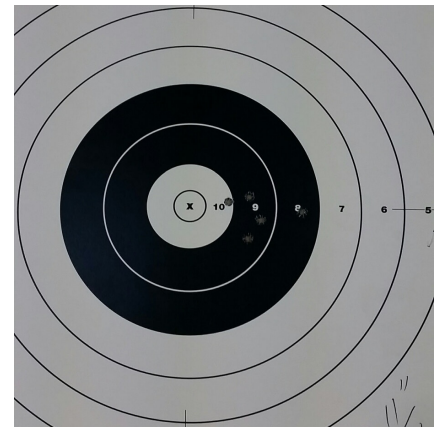
Second in the scoring was Norm Ekman with a 191.04 and Sam Barnier was third highest score with a 181.02.

Prize Shoot and AGM this Saturday

This Saturday the 27th February has the first members prize shoot for the 2016 year which will be a service shoot catering for all as issued, match Iron and match optical rifles.

The shoot will be conducted from the 300m mound and will include a deliberate application as well as a rapid and snap fire on the service Type B target.

2 x sighting shots followed by 10 x shots to score for each detail will be the course of fire. Shooting from this distance in this discipline is typically off the elbows with sling support only.

The shoot has a scheduled start time of 12.30pm so range will be open from 12.00 noon for sign in and prep.

Range fees for this shoot are \$25 where all competitors will get a pick of the prize table.

The 2016 TPVRC Annual General Meeting will be held on range in the club house at the completion of the presentation and prize table for the service shoot. All members are encouraged to attend.
