



Preparing for your International Vacation

Some items may not apply in your case:

Passport (record it's serial number, date and place of issue separately)
Visa only if requested by travel agency
Driver's license for extra ID purposes (optional)
Small pad lock and key for your bags
Immunization card / yellow fever card showing current inoculations (if applicable)
Anti-malaria tabs (Larium - check with your doctor) May be required for some countries
Special medicines / prescriptions you wish to have
Cigarettes – if you smoke (2 carton limit)
Prescription eye glasses / sunglasses
Camera and plenty of film
Extra batteries for your camera
Travel alarm clock
Kleenex (several packs – travel size)
Wash n Dri Wipes (one box)
Laundry soap (small size) your favorite bar or shower jell (travel size) optional
Sewing kit (including small buttons, scissors, safety pins
Cello-tape or zip lock bags for packing or sealing small items
Insect repellent or skin so soft lotion or any lotion with insect repellent
Sunscreen lotion
Pocket flashlight
Compact umbrella
Plastic folding hangers (small quantity) optional
Personal cosmetics and toiletries
Plastic bags for laundry, leaking items, damp swimsuits etc.
Snacks (packing size) for long trips –2 or more hours on the road optional
Pack - casual spring & summer clothing and comfortable walking shoes (light weight)
Cloths should be interchangeable, one or two casual dressy outfits

Proper ID's are a must: A legal Passport is required. Check with your travel agent. Passport & Visa must be purchased at own expense. Most Countries motor coaches/transportation can only accommodate 1 large luggage, so pack wisely & lightly.
