#### **<u>RULES</u>:**

1. California Dressage Society standards and rules will guide the judge. 2. Twisted-wire snaffle bits, kimberwicks, curb bits, martingales, tie-downs, bell boots, and wraps are prohibited. Standard snaffle bits, bitless bridles, and barefoot boots are allowed. Dressage, English, Western, or Australian saddles are allowed. 3. Attire: Approved helmets required for ALL riders. Boots and long or short sleeved shirts required. Horses need not be braided. 4. Unruly or dangerous horses will be excused from the show grounds. 5. All classes are open to horses, ponies, and mules. 6. NO DOGS allowed. 7. Riders must provide their own test readers, if needed. 8. Riding times will be phoned or emailed on the Thursday before the show. 9. Management may change classes as needed.

#### Highland Springs Equestrian Center Release of Liability and Waiver

This RELEASE of LIABILITY is made and entered into on this date: \_Saturday, April 16, 2016\_\_, by and between Highland Springs Equestrian Center, LLC, Paul Marchand, and Juliana Vidich, hereinafter designated MANAGERS, and

(rider name) hereinafter designated RIDER, and if Rider is a minor, Rider's parent or guardian, \_\_\_\_\_\_. In return for the use, today and on all future dates, of the property, facilities and services of the Managers, the Rider, his heirs, assigns, and legal representatives, hereby expressly agree to the following:

1. It is the responsibility of the Rider to carry full and complete insurance coverage on her horse, personal property and herself.

2. Rider agrees to assume ANY AND ALL RISKS INVOLVED IN OR ARISING FROM THE RIDER'S USE OF OR PRES-ENCE UPON MANAGERS' PROPERTY AND FACILITIES including, without limitation but not limited to, the risks of death, bodily injury, property damage, falls, kicks, bites, collisions with vehicles, horses or stationary objects, fire or explosion, the unavailability of emergency medical care, or the negligence or deliberate act of another person.

3. Rider agrees to hold Manager and all of its successors, assigns, subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, employees and agents completely harmless and not liable and release them from all liability whatsoever and AGREES NOT TO SUE them on account of or in connection with any claims, causes of action, injuries, damages, cost or expenses arising out of Rider's use of or presence upon Manager's property and facilities, including without limitation, those based on death, bodily injury, property damage, including consequential damages, except if the damages are caused by the direct, willful and wanton negligence of the Manager.

4. Rider agrees to waive the protection afforded by any statute or law in any jurisdiction whose purpose, substance and/or effect is to provide that a general release shall not extend to claims, material or otherwise, which the person giving the release does not know or suspect to exist at the time of executing the release.

5. Rider agrees to indemnify and defend Manager against, and hold it harmless from, any and all claims, causes of action, damages, judgements, costs or expenses, including attorney's fees, which in any way arise from the Rider's use of or presence upon the Manager's property and facilities.

6. Rider agrees to abide by all of Managers' rules and regulations.

7. If Rider is using her horse, the horse shall be free from infection, contagious or transmissible disease. Manager reserves the right to refuse horse if not in proper health or is deemed dangerous or undesirable.

8. This contract is non-assignable and non-transferable and is made and entered into the State of California, and shall be enforced and interpreted under the laws of this state. Should any clause be in conflict with State Law, then that clause is null and void. When the Manager and Rider and Rider's parent or guardian, if Rider is a minor, sign this contract, it will then be binding on both parties, subject to the above terms and conditions.

9. Rider authorizes the Managers to market, transfer, assign, or otherwise make use of any photographs, likenesses, films, broadcasts, cable casts, audiotapes, or videotapes taken of the horse(s) and participants while on the grounds, incident to, or in transit between the stabling facility and the event site, in any way they see fit, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.
