

From the Desk of Father Rick Schilli

The Solemnity of Pentecost ranks third in importance of all Christian celebrations. We tend to underplay it because a civil holiday is not attached and no presents are exchanged. However, in reality, after the gift of the Incarnation and the gift of Risen Life at Easter, the outpouring of the Holy Spirit is most certainly the greatest gift of the Father to the human race. Today celebrates how the Holy Spirit animates and guides the Church, protecting it from falsehood and error. The Spirit speaks the Truth using the voice of the Church itself as the medium of that speech. That is why the miracle of the languages is so vital to our understanding of the work of the Spirit. Today the Church urges us to stir into flame the gift that is given to us.
