



From the Desk of Father Rick Schilli

Traditionally, the Latin name given to the **Third Sunday of Advent** is **Gaudete Sunday** taken from the ancient Latin chant would begin the Mass: **Gaudete in Domino semper, iterum dico gaudete** which translates: "**Rejoice in the Lord, always, I say it again, rejoice!**" With Gaudete Sunday we move further into Advent and begin to relate the stories attached to the Infancy Narratives of the Gospel and the prophecies of Isaiah regarding the coming of the Messiah. *And so our joy increases*. Only ten days remain until Christmas. Our preparation is not yet complete and there is still much time to ponder the mystery of the Incarnation. Our liturgy is brightened by the use of rose vestments suggest the darkness of a world without a savior is somewhat brighter than when Advent began, yet not as bright as Christmas promises to be. In his First Coming the Messiah enters human history and provokes a conversion in us which allows the saving work of Christ to enlighten the entire world. *We continue to long for that light.*




ANNUAL SPIRIT OF CHRISTMAS GIVING TREE

Lord, may it be done to me according to your word". Don't let this opportunity


