

MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS, 1st April 2016 to 31st March 2019

Tenders are invited for the contract to maintain the Public Footpaths as per the following for the period 1^{st} April 2016 to 31^{st} March 2019.

It is intended to put in place a 3 year contract, which can be reviewed annually. This will only continue each year if positive performance, site reviews and assessments are made. It has been agreed that for the duration of this contract no annual increases will be made.

Intention to terminate the rolling contract may take place in writing from either party providing a minimum of 6 weeks' written notice is given to coincide with the end of each annual period (31st March).

The contract is set out in two parts, the South West Coast Path and Inland Rural Footpaths.

We ask that you only provide a cost for the full 3 year span of the contract period for both parts.

It will be expected that the successful contractor provide their own transport and equipment, as well as being expected to wear appropriate personal protective equipment in line with Health and Safety legislation. Pre-work risk assessments, COSHH assessments and any other relevant Health and Safety paperwork including details on traffic management and the authority to work within the highway corridor if applicable will be expected prior to works commencing. Since these paths cannot be closed whilst being worked on, we would expect appropriate signage to be erected at both ends of any areas being worked.

A copy of a valid public liability and a personal accident insurance policy must be attached to this tender.

Additional Small Works

There is the scope that additional minor works/ extra cuts may be requested over the period of the contract. These would be of a similar nature to those included within the body of the contract, which would be required to be invoiced as a separate item. We would appreciate it if you would include an hourly rate applicable for these should the need arise.

General specifications for both parts:

The work consists of strimming/brushcutting/mowing vegetation from those paths specified. Paths will need to be cleared of growth to a width of 1.5 metres and height of 2 metres centred on the path's centreline. Where fencing/obstruction precludes this width being obtained the path will be cleared to the fence/obstruction. All trimmings must be removed from underfoot – they can be swept back /incorporated into the facing of hedges at ground level. It is vital that the path is left open and easy to use after trimming is carried out and must not be left obstructed. Any steps will need to be cleared of mud and debris.

Japanese knotweed must be left alone. DO NOT CUT OR PULL IT UP as this could cause it to spread. Please tie it back if you can. Please report the location of any knotweed (or any other invasive non-native plants) seen to be growing on or immediately adjacent to a path to the Parish Council.

Cuts should be made in April after the bracken has developed and late July when brambles have matured. Where a single cut is specified this should take place in July.

Part 1: the South West Coast Path

The relevant sections of the SWCP are those which **do not lie within National Trust land, which are maintained by the Trust themselves**. The schedule is for ease of identification on the enclosed map.

Footpath No. 2	Penwarne Road	Penwarne Road to 1 st stile. Trimming of stiles at both ends of this section and the clearing of the entrance in Penwarne Road.	2
Footpath Nos. 8 & 4	Penwarne Road	Clear and trim back stiles and the entrances to these footpaths of briars etc. on both sides of Penwarne Road.	2
Footpaths 7 & 8	Boskensoe to Bosanath Road	Clear and trim around the stiles and entrance to Boskensoe to Bosanath Road.	2
Footpath No. 8	Boskensoe to Tregarne	Clear entrances and stiles on both sides of the Boskensoe to Tregarne	2
Footpath No. 9	Carlidnack Road	From Carlidnack Road between properties only, in the direction of Boskensoe. Stiles at either end of section to be trimmed, along with stile exit onto Sampys Hill.	2
Footpath No. 10	The Round Field (Carlidnack Road)	From the end of the metalled road south of The Round Field, in the direction of Maenporth to the stream.	2
Footpath No. 11		From gate at Maenporth along lower edge to the start of the old woodland.	2
Footpath No. 15	Grove Hill	From Grove Hill in the direction of Penpol to the first stile.	2

3 sections of Bridleway are also included within this contract and should be cleared to a width of 2.5m and a height of 3.5m where the path corridor allows. They require 2 cuts per year.

Bridleway 6: Carlidnack Road towards Maenporth (field area only) approx. 175m



The Parish Council will not be responsible for any maintenance to equipment or any damage caused to contractor's equipment.

All materials, machinery, plant, expertise and health and safety precautions are to be provided by the contractor as part of this contract. No chemicals, equipment or plant is to be left unattended during the course of the fulfilment of this contract. Public safety is of utmost importance to the Parish Council and appropriate care needs to be taken to enact this contract with them in mind as all areas within it are open to the public, including when works are taking place. Complaints from the public about the working practices or conduct of contractors are dealt with seriously and, if investigated and found to be of a sufficiently serious nature, may result in the immediate termination of the contract.

At some point it may be noted by the contractor that additional small works are required outside of the normal scope of this contract to ensure the suitable & safe completion of works. These works should be brought to the attention of the clerk as soon as possible to be assessed.

It is a condition of this contract that when carrying out the work described therein, the contractor must hold a valid public liability and a personal accident insurance policy. A copy of these must be attached to this tender and updated annually.
