

Council Minutes

The regular meeting of the St. Paul Lutheran Church Council was held on Thursday, July 9, 2009.

PRESENT: President Frank Maguire, Vice President Kirk Vorthmann, Secretary Dianna Smith,

Jim Karr, Patty Walter, Susan Goos, and Pastor Norris. ABSENT: Treasurer John Swalwell

DEVOTIONS: Mark 6:35-44 was read by Pastor Norris and opened up for reflection and responses.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: None

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 PM by President Frank Maguire. Consent items were passed by measure of voice vote. The Consent Items on the agenda were: Approval of the minutes, Youth Leaders Report, Pastor's Report, Treasurer's Report & Other Written Reports, Approval of Bills, Transfer/Release Membership, and Evaluation of Past Activities.

Student Loan Approval was discussed. There were suggestions received for a couple of small changes to the loan application. Kirk motioned to accept the revised loan application. Patty seconded. Approved by voice vote. Five students were approved for a loan of \$500.00 each. Those five students are Isaac Schmidt, Sam Schmidt, Morgan Vorthmann, Lindsay Wilson, and Josh Lambert.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: The first item of unfinished business was a review of the Visa bill. Charges looked to be acceptable. It was agreed that the council would not need to review the bill every month.

The second item of unfinished business was a review of the plans for the suggested playground. Patty motioned to approve the plans, with the okay to start whenever the preschool is ready. Seconded by Susan.

NEW BUSINESS: The first item of new business was budget development. The deadline for budget requests is set for August 20th so that the council can take a cursory look at the budget items at the August 27th meeting with the regular budget planning meeting scheduled for September 3rd. A line by line look at the existing budget was done to determine who would be responsible for which items.

The second item of new business was a discussion of how many members would need to be replaced on the existing Facility Needs Team and who may be interested in taking their place. Contact will be made with each of the people on the list to see if they would like to join the team.

The third item of new business was to set a date for Pastor Appreciation month. Since October already has a full schedule, September 27th was chosen to appreciate both the Pastor and Youth Minister.

The next regular meeting of the council was set for August 13 at 7:00 PM.

The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer at 9:30 PM.

SPY HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Outreach Team – WATER FUN!! Please note that we have changed our summer water fun activity to be Friday, July 31st, from 7pm to 10pm at the Green Meadows Private Pool in Co. Bluffs on ParkView just off of Franklin and Cloverdale. We will roast hot dogs and smores and from 8 to 10pm we will have the pool all to ourselves! A parent/insurance authorization form needs to be on file with Denise to attend this event – one will be sent in the mail to all youth this week along with more details of this event. The cost is \$2 - please call or text Denise if you want to sign up to go or if you would like to be an adult driver.

Impact Team - SPY served at Mohm's Place on Sunday, June 28th. The youth were given a tour of the new facility which is much bigger than the old Mohm's and the new facility also includes a sleeping area for homeless men and a transitional living area for them to work towards moving out on their own. The youth then helped prepare and serve the evening meal to over 90 people and then cleaned up the kitchen and dining area.

On Sunday, July 19th, we went to the Micah House for a tour of their facilities. One to two parent families are allowed to stay for 30 days and served three meals a day. They also have two rooms that can house 2 single women in each room. As we helped serve the meal, the children staying there were very excited to have young people serving them and we were able to visit and play with the children after cleaning up the kitchen area. We hope to go back and serve again and to plan some games to play with the children.

Small Group Ministry Team Makes Plans For Fall

A new Small Group Ministry team has been formed and has begun making plans for encouraging small group participation this fall. Beginning September 13, Pastor Norris is planning to do a sermon series on the book of James. The Small Group Ministry team is suggesting that as small groups start meeting this fall, that they consider using a study focusing on James. Samples of materials on James will be available for people to look at to make sure the material fit their group. A couple of choices will be offered.

Most people have a high regard for the Bible, in theory at least. Yet, I recently heard about one survey that found that in a given year only 6% of the members in an average congregation participated in any kind of Bible study and that only about half had *ever* participated in a study of the Bible.

If the Bible is to have any real impact on our lives, we need to be reading the Word and learning from it on a regular basis. Small groups are an excellent place for this to happen.

During the sermon series (and probably after it is finished), I plan to lead a larger group study of James during the Sunday school hour. The study will take place in the church fellowship hall. I am looking forward to what we can discover in this somewhat neglected book for the Bible.

The Small Group Ministry team would like to know which small groups are already planning to begin meeting this fall. If you are part of a small group that is planning to start meeting again this fall, please let the church office know and give us the name of a contact person for the group so the team knows where to send small group information.

The Small Group Ministry team is also looking for individuals who would be willing to host a new small group either in their home or at the church. If you are interested, please contact the church office about that as well.

New Facility Needs Team Being Formed

The church council has been working on creating a new Facility Needs team to continue working on plans that would address needs that have been identified by the congregation.

At this point, it looks as if there will be an even balance between those who served on the previous team and new members. Some members of the previous team have decided not to continue. When the team has been finalized, their names will be communicated to the congregation.

Jim Nord is planning to meet with the new team and the church council on Saturday, August 8 to help us plan the next steps we need to take.

I appreciate the work that the previous team did, but I do think it is time for new blood on the team. Our goal continues to be the same: to discern where God is leading our congregation.

Staff Support Committee

The Staff Support Committee is a committee established by the congregational constitution. The constitution specifies that the committee should be appointed jointly by the president, vice president and pastor. The term of office is for two years, with three persons appointed to the committee each successive year. Committee members are to hold no other office in the congregation during their term. (They may, however, service on one of the congregation's ministry teams.)

The bylaws of the constitution spell our the duties of the Staff Support Committee as follows:

- a. The Staff Support committee shall serve as a channel of communication between the congregation and Pastor and Youth minister.
- b. The Staff Support Committee shall assist the Pastor and Congregation Council in developing and overseeing personnel policies for all called and hired employees of this Congregation, review their job performance and compensation annually and make appropriate recommendations to the Congregation council.

At their most recent meeting, the staff support team once again reviewed these duties. As a channel of communication, they recognize that it is important for them to keep from getting in the middle of the communication between congregation members and members of the church staff. Rather they see their role as encouraging and facilitating direct communication between congregation members and church staff.
