Camera Operators

Duties and responsibilities: Camera operators should be knowledgeable about a wide range of technological equipment, as they will be in charge of all equipment (camera, cables, microphone, etc). They will operate the camera as well as assist with video editing. Prior experience as a camera operator and movie editing software (especially Wirecast) is an asset.

Commentators

Duties and responsibilities: The commentators will be responsible for researching teams prior to game day and writing their own script for interviews and commentary. They should have a strong base of sports knowledge, and a vibrant, enthusiastic personality. Commentators will specialize in one or two sports throughout the year.
