De Ja Vu, all over again!!

Also new this year is our 1988 thru 2004 HIGHLIGHTS VIDEO.

The **2005 DVD/Video** covers soil preparation, adjusting Ph, cover crops, seed starting, setting out your small plants, greenhouses, using mycorrhizae, determining main vine direction, and manipulating the trailing vine to help alleviate stem stress. We also show building a portable watering stand, and pumpkin shading strategy that allows for late season thermal exposure, as well as burying vines, plant pruning and hand pollination. Some favorite hand tools are displayed and a demonstration is shown on using a pumpkin lifting device. There is also an informative sequence showing collecting seeds and processing them.

We will take you to the exciting weigh-offs of the Puyallup Fair, Lee Farms, the Pumpkin Palace, Central Market and of course "The Granddaddy" Half Moon Bay, where I defend my 2004 Championship with a 2nd straight win. We also visit other growers, such as Leonardo Urena, the new California State Record holder, and Don and Geneva Emmons, former World Record Holders, who demonstrate their new "compost tea" system, and show their gourd, which is over 10-feet long!

Our **"Highlights Video"** features never before seen footage from 1988-1991, and goes on to show some of the important events through 2004, a total of 17 years in all!

My World Record 827# is shown as well as my 2nd in the world in 1992, the 722#. 4 of the top 10 pumpkins in the world are shown in the 1993 segment, including Don Black's World Record 884#. In 1994 we show the Japanese National Champion and a New World Record by Herman Bax that misses being the 1st 1,000# pumpkin by 10 pounds. In 1995 see Paula and Nathan Zehr's 968/963 which won 2 major World Titles for the year. In 1996, you'll see the World Famous Greer 1,006# and also see the awesome carved pumpkins at Disneyland. 1997 features an interview with World Champion Chris Anderson with his 977# pumpkin. HOLLAND'S LAND O'GIANTS 2005 SEEDSTOCK

1,229#-'05: 374" (723 Bobier X 1,260 Weir) Tied my personal best and was the Half Moon Bay Winning pumpkin. It had a nice orange color. It weighed 12.2% heavy based on the newest chart.

1,166#: 372" (995 Holland X 1,260 Weir) This fruit was very long with no sign of a sag line, very smooth and crack free inside and out. It was light orange, and weighed 8.1% over the chart.

1,161#: 358.5" (869.5 Calai X 1,229#-'04 Holland) If I had known this nice, orange pumpkin was this heavy I would not have picked it on September 23rd. It was still growing well at over 8 pounds a day! It went 20.2% heavy.

1,014#: 349" (1,229#-'04 Holland X 1,127 Holland) This was a nice trouble free orange fruit that grew steady all season. Weighed 13.6% over the chart.

953#: 359.5" (1,127 Holland X 1,260 Weir) This was a nice orange pumpkin harvested early for the Puyallup Fair. It would have easily exceeded 1,000# with a little more growing time. It weighed very close to the chart.

943#: 333.5" (805 Pukos X 1,260 Weir) This cream-colored fruit is from the seed stock that produced my 1,229#-'04. It was a high, round heavy fruit that weighed 20.8% over the weight chart.

911#: 341" (961 Daletas X 1,127 Holland) It was a pinkish-orange, solid pumpkin with no flaws, and weighed 9.3% heavy.

736#EST.: 327" (1,260 Weir X 1,127 Holland) This pumpkin came on late in the season. The main fruit on this plant had a stem-split earlier. It was not weighed-estimated from the chart only.

729#-Est.: 326" (805 Pukos X 869.5 Calai) This was the second fruit on the 805# Pukos, which produced the 943#. It was cream-colored, high, round and trouble-free. It wasn't weighed, estimated only from the chart.

FERTILIZER PROGRAM

PLEASE NOTE: Do not exceed recommended application rates for soluble fertilizers. More frequent-lighter applications are more effective than less frequent heavy doses. When pumpkins are in their heavy growth phase and later in the season, you should consider cutting back on fertilizers and water if pumpkins are on a good growth curve, especially if sag lines or stem splits are presented.

Initial Preparation and Planting

**Previous Fall
(preferred)
Early Spring**

Add organic matter, compost, manure and/or plant cover crop.
Make needed PH adjustments. Add nutrients in the Spring based on results of your soil test.

Planting Seeds

Soak seeds in a solution of ½ teaspoon Soluble Seaweed Powder in 1-quart of warm water. Mix 3.5 ounces of Bio-Endo Plus in each 1-cubic foot of seed starting mix.

Planting

Mix 3.5 ounces of Bio-Grow Endo Plus into each 1 cubic ft. of soil excavated for planting holes. Water the seedlings in with Soluble Seaweed/Fish Powder combo in warm water. Mix each at half the normal rate. The instructions for initial mixing are on the labels.

Month-By-Month Suggestions

In May

Water the plants at the base as needed, alternating Soluble Seaweed, Calcium, and Soluble Fish with plain water. Example: Soluble Seaweed-plain warm water-Calcium solution-plain warm water-Soluble Fish -plain warm water. When plants reach the 5 true leaf stage do a Combination of foliar applications and feeding directly on the soil in An area 2 to 3 times larger than the plant.

In June

Mondays (or 1 time a week) Soluble Seaweed Foliar Spray
Wednesdays (or 1 time a week) Calcium Solution Foliar Spray

The same as June-but *consider cutting back on fertilizers and water if the pumpkins are on a high-growth curve or if sag-lines or stem-splits become evident.

In August

Continue the same with Seaweed and Calcium. Every 10-14 days Use a Soluble Fish foliar spray. * Use the same considerations as in July.

In September

Same applications of Seaweed and Calcium. 2 times a month apply Soluble Fish foliar spray. *Use same considerations as previous months.

In October

Use the same Seaweed and Calcium applications. Delete Fish Applications.

I have been doing a lot of research into products that will help Giant Pumpkin Growers overcome the limiting effects of soil pathogens such as Fusarium, Pythium and Phytophthora. The effects of soil pathogens are widespread and can limit the potential of your plants at low levels and completely wipe out pumpkin plants at high levels. BioGrow Endo Plus inoculates the roots of pumpkin plants with the critical Endomycorrhizal Fungi that all cucurbits need to grow strong and resist disease. BioGrow Endo Plus is like two products in one. It has the beneficial Endomycorrhizal Fungi and also contains two strains of Trichoderma, which is the active beneficial microbe in the product Rootshield, another powerful tool against soil pathogens. BioGrow Endo Plus comes as a dry granular media containing the dormant beneficial microbes. Mix some into the potting mix in which you start your seeds and also mix some into the planting hole when you set your plants out in the patch. The Endomycorrhizae and Trichoderma inoculate the growing roots and a beneficial symbiotic system is formed. The microbes grow out with the expanding root system, and colonize the entire growing area. Directions for use: Thoroughly mix 3.5 ounces of BioGrow into each 1 cubic foot of potting soil or seed starting mix before filling pots for planting. When setting out transplants thoroughly mix 3.5 ounces of BioGrow into each 1 cubic foot of soil that is removed to make your planting hole. Backfill inoculated soil under where the plant will go and all around the root ball or peat pot to get immediate contact with emerging roots. LAND O' GIANTS Soluble Seaweed Powder is a super concentrated soluble organic product. Now you can get all the goodness of Norwegian Seaweed *without* paying for water and paying to ship water! Each 10.7-ounce packet of powder is equal to 1 gallon of concentrate.

Norwegian seaweed contains a complex matrix of natural plant growth stimulants, including gibberellins, auxins, betraines and cytokinins. These are the factors that influence cell elongation, differentiation, and cell division.

Norwegian seaweed is also rich in naturally chelated minerals and trace elements, carbohydrates, vitamins, and amino acids. Norwegian seaweed also contains primary and secondary plant nutrients. Foliar applications of Norwegian seaweed stimulate photosynthesis, resulting in a more efficient production of sugars and starches. Liquid fish emulsions also require powerful stabilizers and preservatives to avoid spoilage. **Soluble Fish Powder** is completely dry and requires no additives. It is also most economical as you pay for product only and not water! **Soluble Fish Powder** is less expensive to ship, easier to handle, and more stable in storage. The soluble fish takes a little more work to thoroughly mix, compared with the seaweed powder. I use very warm water and mix once, and then I let it sit for 20 minutes or so, and stir a second time.

This is a perfect partner to our **Soluble Seaweed Powder**. **The Soluble Fish Powder** provides more nitrogen and macronutrients and the **Soluble Seaweed Powder** provides the essential trace minerals, growth promoting hormones, and has up to 6% potassium. The two products can be mixed with each other for a combo-spray, or applied separately. Both are also compatible with regular soluble fertilizers such as Peter's or Miracle Grow. 1 pound of **Soluble Fish Powder** is equal to 2 gallons of liquid fish emulsion concentrate.

BioMin Calcium

Calcium doesn't translocate through a plant as readily as some nutrients. When things are really rolling, the plant may have difficulty moving sufficient calcium from the roots to the growing tips and fruit. Foliar spraying calcium can be very effective. **BioMin Calcium** is similar to Calcium Metasolate, but is higher in available calcium. **BioMin** is a highly effective foliar fertilizer, especially when used during the active growth stage.

Perfect Pin Nozzles

These are my "favorite" small sprinklers to use inside the greenhouse. I use 3 in each greenhouse mounted over the young plant on a 10-foot section of PVC pipe. A demonstration of how to build the unit is in the 2001 Holland's Land O' Giants Video. It requires drilling 7/16" holes in the plastic pipe. A rubber insert is pushed into the hole and then the small sprinkler will self-tap into the opening. It requires clean water.

Whizzer Type Sprinkler

These are the yellow revolving sprinklers you can see being used in my videos. They are typically mounted on top of a 4-foot high-riser, near the center of each plant. They water in a circular pattern and distribute the water evenly. The size of the circle covered can be controlled by how much volume is allowed past the faucet or valve. I can usually vary the watering pattern from about 8-feet to nearly 45-feet in diameter.

Pumpkin Measurement and Weight Estimate Tapes

This is a 16-foot soft-flexible measuring tape which also gives the estimated weight of your pumpkin starting at 42 pounds and going up to 1,422 pounds.

4-inch Peat Pots

The 4-inch size needed for starting Giant Pumpkin seeds are getting very hard to find. The 4-inch size allows enough volume to hold the plants a few extra days if the weather is not co-operating or you need more time to finish up the cloches. I have always punched many extra holes in the 4-in. peat pots I have used to insure good drainage and root penetration and then set the plant out, pot and all. Unless the seed starting mix is even with the top of the pot, I usually trim off the top of the pots when setting the plants out.

4 ft. X 4 ft. Black Grow Mats

I have been using these mats since the mid-1990's. Many growers have asked about them after seeing them on our videos. The mats help to warm up the soil around the young pumpkin plants, plus help keep down the weeds. They also provide a soil covering that catches and receives water and helps prevent splashing soil on the young seedlings. The lightweight plastic material, known as Vispore, has thousands of tiny holes, which are funnel shaped to direct water through. The Vispore has a shiny side and a dull side. To properly utilize the funnel shaped holes, the shiny side must be facing up and the dull side will be in contact with the soil. We custom configure each mat for pumpkin growing. The mats come with a slit to the center where there is an expandable 4" opening to accommodate the rowing stem. Vispore is lightweight (3 mil.) so the edges must be anchored to prevent the wind from moving them. I use scrap pieces of 1" to 2" boards cut approximately the length of each side.

Tall Corn Seed

This vigorous variety of corn will normally reach heights of 12 to 16 feet, with good care. Occasionally with excellent weather and culture, the variety may reach 18 to 20 feet. When the plants are 4 to 5 feet any suckers should be removed from the base. Soil should be mounded around the stalk, as new roots will go down from each ring or joint. This will stabilize the plant in the wind and allow for better growth with the larger root system.

Giant Sunflower Seeds

Grey Stripe Variety: Has heavy stalks, huge leaves and mammoth heads that can be 16 to 24 inches across. Plants are normally 8 to 12 feet, and may need staking or a fence to lean on or be tied to.

White Seeded Variety: Compared to other giant varieties, this cultivar has more uniform flower heads that normally stay flat and round. Giant heads can get up to 24 inches. Plants sometimes reach 10 to 14 feet, and may need staking or a fence to lean on or be tied to.

Sunny Boy: This is a multi-headed ornamental variety that produces a profusion of beautiful flowers.
