

Misconduct Policy

Healing Hands Ministries Inc. reserves the right to refuse services to patients that have conducted themselves in a manner that is considered inappropriate. In appropriate behavior is defined as using foul language towards a member of the staff or another patient, being loud and disruptive in the waiting area, being intoxicated by drugs and/or alcohol and threatening any staff member or another patient or harassing a staff member or another patient. These are examples of misconduct and misconduct is not limited to these actions only.

I understand that should I behave inappropriately, I will be warned, and could be dismissed from the clinic and will no longer be eligible to obtain services from HHM. I also understand that, depending of the severity of the incident, dismissal may be immediate. All incidents will be reviewed by a HHM physician and the executive director.
