Not be a current District or International officer, nor have declared the intent to run for District or International office (i.e. District Treasurer, Area Governor, etc.) 4. Area, Division and District contests: Not be presenters of educational sessions at the event at which the contest is held. **Procedures** 6 Note: If time is an issue, no need to explain the rules. 5. Recording speeches or taking pictures during the contest is not permitted without the

- preauthorization of the Contest Chair; if allowed, it will not distract the contestants.
- 6. Turn off pagers, cell phones or any object that might make noise during the contest.
- 7. No one is allowed in or out of the room while a contestant is speaking.
- 8. All speeches must be original. Any quoted material must be identified.
- 9. To eliminate perception of bias, introduce each contestant as follows:

Time of speech is 5 - 7 minutes. Speeches less than 4 minutes 30 seconds or more than 7 minutes 30 seconds will be disqualified.

- 11. The lights will be activated as follows (ensure the timekeepers activate the lights/cardboards as you indicate timelines):
 - a. Green Light at 5 minutes
 - b. Amber Light at 6 minutes
 - c. Red Light at 7 minutes and will stay on until the speaker has finished speaking. No notice shall be given to indicate a speaker has gone overtime.
- 12. There will be one minute of silence between speakers.
- 13. Protests may be entered ONLY by the contestants or judges to either the Chief Judge and/or Contest Chair.
- 14. After the results are announced, all decisions are final.
