

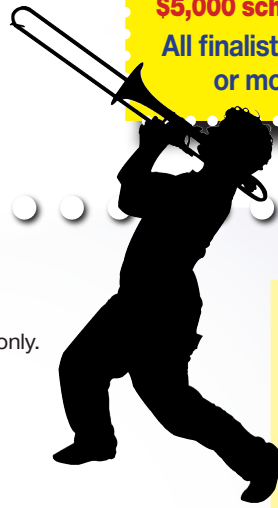

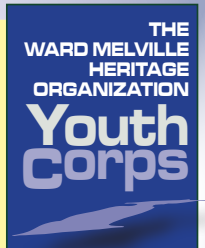
OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

- Long Island students 10-17 years of age in Nassau or Suffolk County. Students must still be in high school at the time award is given in October 2015.
- Entry Categories: Non-professional vocal performances & musical instruments only.
- Students are limited to one (1) three minute performance.
- Must supply own equipment.
- Dress code (family show).
- No drugs/alcohol.
- Proof of age must be submitted along with DVD.
- Entry Fee - \$25.
- WMHO reserves the right to reject any entry that we deem to be offensive to the general public.
- Contestants advancing to the finals must perform (three minutes) at one of WMHO's summer concerts (Sundays in July & August)

PERFORMANCE PROCEDURE

- Submit an audition DVD no longer than two (2) minutes recording your talent. (DVDs cannot be returned.) You can also provide a link to a YouTube video of your performance, if you prefer.
- If contacted after submission you will be asked to perform at The Educational & Cultural Center in Stony Brook Village Center on **April 17 at 6:30 pm**. A distinguished panel of judges will choose seven finalists.
- The seven finalists will perform at WMHO's Summer Concerts on Sunday evenings in July and August 2015. A panel of audience members will select a "fan favorite!"
- The finalists will perform in October 2015 at WMHO's Educational & Cultural Center in Stony Brook Village. Winners of Long Island's Got Talent 2015 will be announced at that time.
