- 3. Tournament team roster can be handed-in on day of tournament.
- 4. ELCO High School coaches and players will referee.
- 5. Concessions will be available on-site. No outside food or drinks will be permitted.
- 6. Spectator fee \$3.00 for adults, \$2.00 for students.

ELCO UNITED BOYS INDOOR TOURNAMENT Rules and Regulations

All outdoor rules apply except for the following:

- 1. There are no off-sides.
- 2. All substitutions are made on the fly.
- 3. Keepers can throw the ball, but it may not cross midfield in the air.
- 4. Keepers cannot punt or drop-kick the ball.
- 5. Keepers can place the ball on the ground and kick it over half (ball is live). Infraction of any of the Keeper rules will result in an indirect kick at midfield.

There is no slide tackling. A slide tackle will result in a direct kick from the point of the infraction. A 2-minute penalty will be accessed.

There is no boarding or pushing into the sideline bleachers. A direct kick will result from the point of the foul and a 2-minute penalty will be accessed.

If a **player kicks the ball and it hits the ceiling,** a 2-minute penalty will be accessed and the opposing team is awarded a direct kick from the approximate spot where the ball hit the ceiling. If the team with a power-play (person advantage) scores, the penalty is over and the short-handed team may return to full strength.

Players must be 8 feet away from the spot of the ball on free kicks.

Play will continue on any ball that comes back into play from the sideline bleachers. If the ball does not return to play, a kick-in will be awarded.

No cleats or turf shoes, only sneakers. Shin guards are required for all players.

Any fighting among players, coaches, and/or fans will result in immediate ejection of the person or possibly the team based on the incident (ELCO staff discretion).

It will be the honor system for the coaches to use only age appropriate players (fall age group applies). If a team is caught using an illegal age (older) player, the team will be disqualified from the tournament. The entry fee will not be returned.

Each age group winner will be determined by a point system: 3 for a win, 1 for a tie and a possible + 1 bonus point for a shutout (no bonus points will be awarded for a 0-0 draw).

If two or more teams are tied on points at the end of play, the tie breaker determination will be in the following order: Head to Head, Goal Differential (maximum +5 per game), Goals Against, Flip of Coin.

No protests allowed. Please respect the referee's decisions. In the event of an issue not clearly defined in these rules, the tournament director will have the final say. Good sportsmanship will be the rule of the day and greatly appreciated.
