
Until further notice, Out of School Hours Care will continue in the library.... but not for long!



NOT incur out of pocket expenses with the Child Dental Benefit Schedule

NO FEES ~ YOU WILL BE BULK BILLED!

On January 1<sup>st</sup> 2014, the government introduced the new **Child Dental Benefit Scheme**. Families who receive **Family Tax Benefit Part A** or a relevant Australian Government payment will receive a letter outlining their eligibility.

It entitles all eligible children aged 2-17 years old to general dental care up to the value of \$1000 over 2 years.

Our normal dental care continues to operate for all 0-12 year old children and eligible 13-17 year old youth at no cost. (Youth must be a holder or dependant of a health care or pensioner concessioner card holder, in out-of-home care provided by Department of Human Services or in Custodial Care).

Following their treatment, your child will be placed on our **patient recall system** and receive a reminder letter when their next appointment is due.
