

Heb 1:13-14 But to which of the angels has He ever said, "Sit at My right hand, Until I make Thine enemies A footstool for Thy feet"? Are they not all ministering spirits, sent out to render service for the sake of those who will inherit salvation?

[2] Angelic and demonic beings are created by God

Col 1:16 For by Him all things were created, {both} in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities -- all things have been created by Him and for Him.

[3] Angelic and demonic beings are finite

This is a deduction, from their nature as created beings, though items in [5] below are relevant. This would include finiteness in relation to time and space, and also finiteness in knowledge and power.

[4] Angelic and demonic beings are dependent upon God

This is also a deduction, from their nature as created beings.

[5] Angelic and demonic beings are under the control of God.

Job 1:12 Then the LORD said to Satan, "Behold, all that he has is in your power, only do not put forth your hand on him." So Satan departed from the presence of the LORD.

Rev 20:1-3 And I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key of the abyss and a great chain in his hand. And he laid hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years, and threw him into the abyss, and shut (it) and sealed (it) over him, so that he should not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be released for a short time.

Rev 20:10 And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they
