This spring dancers in the eastern panhandle region of West Virginia are offered a special opportunity to enhance their experience, understanding and skills by participating in a two-day festival of master dance classes and a gala performance.

Dance Works is designed to make available great dance learning experiences in a local venue: the convenient Musselman High School complex. Beginning on Friday afternoon, March 21, and continuing on Saturday, visiting instructors will conduct classes designed for beginning and intermediate to advanced dancers ages 10 and up, in ballet, modern, jazz, and techniques for partnering. Contemporary dance styles and somatics are also being scheduled. Teachers and class schedules are being finalized and will be announced shortly.

With a focus on helping young dancers to develop a perspective on their lives in dance after high school, a panel discussion on dance education and other opportunities will also be part of the program.

On Saturday evening, a special gala performance at 7:00 p.m. will feature visiting guest performers as well as an opportunity for local groups to share their dance pieces with friends and neighbors. DANCER REGISTRATION:

See below for description of ability levels for assignment to classes.

- Fee for each dancer registering is \$60.
- Individual dancers may register to attend the master classes. Due to time constraints performances are limited to studios and companies, and guest artists.
- Dancers may perform with more than one company, but need to pay only one registration fee. Indicate on the form if a dancer is shared and include the name on both rosters.

IMPORTANT: Please be sure that all those registering read the Code of Conduct, release information, and photo/video release. Submitting a registration indicates that the dancer agrees to and will adhere to these provisions.

Directors, please indicate placement for your students in the correct class by ability:

- Beginner: Minimum age 10 with two years of classical ballet training. Previous exposure to jazz and modern techniques.
- Intermediate: Minimum 2-3 years of dance training at two or more ballet classes per week and fundamental knowledge of jazz and modern techniques.
- Advanced: Minimum 4-5 years of concentrated ballet study with a fluid knowledge of jazz and modern techniques.

CONDUCT DURING THE EVENT

The Dance Works Festival celebrates the art of dance and its value and importance to young dancers and the community. Those who register to participate indicate by signing up that they will recognize and adhere to the following code of conduct.

- 1. I represent the art of dance and therefore will conduct myself in a courteous, supportive and professional manner at all times.
- 2. I will refrain at all times from using any critical comments, in any language, about individuals, companies and those providing this opportunity.
- 3. I will attend and arrive on time to all classes and other festival events, unless previously excused by my director.
- 4. All cell phones will be turned off during classes, technical rehearsals and performance. There will be no phone calls, texting or other use of phones that interferes with others' privacy or participation.
- 5. I will refrain from eating or chewing gum in any space other than the designated hospitality areas. Only bottled water is allowed in backstage areas unless arranged in advance with the backstage coordinator.
- 6. I will wear some form of cover-up at all times when in public areas.
- 7. I will remember all theatre etiquette when in the audience, such as not talking during performances and remaining seated until the final curtain. I will also refrain from inappropriate cheering and screaming when I am a member of the audience.
- 8. I will respect and follow the instructions of all those in authority, including all company directors, parent/chaperones, and festival coordinators.
- 9. The Dance Works coordinators reserve the right to request anyone not adhering to this code to leave the event. No refunds will be made.

WAIVERS AND RELEASES

By submitting an entry as an individual or as an organization, you and your parent or other responsible party agree to the following WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

I hereby waive all claims for injury, damage, or loss to my child, myself and property during my participation in Dance Works activities and release the Berkeley Arts Council, the Parks and Recreation Board, Musselman High School, the BC Board of Education and participating volunteers from any liability for injury, damage, or loss which may be caused by any act or omission by any of the sponsoring groups.

GUIDELINES:

- Pieces may not exceed 8 minutes in length.
- Each piece will have a 20 minute tech rehearsal. Please have your dancers and times of lighting changes prepared (as counting down with the music). We will not wait for dancers or directors and will not reschedule your tech time.
- When all entries are in we will contact you to schedule your tech time.
- All pieces are limited to 5 lighting cues, plus lights up and lights down.
- Stage is approximately 58 feet including wing space and 30 feet from front of stage to backdrop.
- Backdrop may be either black curtain or cyc.

A lighting diagram of the Musselman stage is included with this packet.
